PARKING

Parking inside the fairgrounds requires a permit to enter. This permit must be requested on the entry form or may be purchased at the Equine Check-In Trailer (which is located on the East side of the grounds, off Stuhr Road) and is for the sole use of the exhibitor. Parking permits are \$15.00 for exhibitors. All vehicles must have an exhibitor parking pass affixed to the driver's side of the front windshield. Parking passes are good for the entire run of the fair. All trucks and trailers will be required to park in designated areas. Fair Management assumes no obligation or liability for any theft or damage that may occur to the vehicle or its contents. DAY PARKING FOR THE DASH FOR CASH BARREL RACING will park behind (NORTHSIDE) of the THOMPSON FOODS OPEN AIR ARENA (outdoors).

ENTRY

The Dash for Cash Barrel Racing will be accepting online entries at www.fastenter.com under Nebraska State Fair Dash for Cash. Mail in entries will also be accepted, by clicking on the Entry form on the Nebraska State Fair website, www.statefair.org. Click on the Get Involved tab, click on Equine, scroll down to Nebraska Dash for Cash Barrel Racing. Mail the completed entry form to Dixie Engelke, 21031 H Road, Athol, KS 66932.

BARREL RACE FEES

Stall Fee: \$35.00 (No exceptions, No tie outs and No building pens)

Tack Room Fee: \$35.00

Exhibitor Ticket: \$5.00 each

Exhibitor Badge: \$25.00 (11 day)

Exhibitions: \$5.00 each

Open Race: \$40(must run in the Open and Roll Times to sidepots)

One Time Office Fee: \$10 per rider

Age Based Sidepots: (age of rider as of January 1, 2018)

- Youth \$20 (18 & Under) plus \$5.00 office fee
- Adult \$20 (19 – 54) plus \$5.00 office fee
- Senior \$20 (55 & Over) plus \$5.00 office fee

Open 4D Race: \$4000 Added Minimum

Open 4D payout, is OVER 250 entries in the open will be payout on a 5D format for the Open.
Buckles / Plaques awarded on 5D regardless of payout.

POLE BENDING FEES

(Tuesday, Only After the OPEN)

Entry Fee: \$20 plus \$5 office fee

- *Youth* (18 & Under): \$15 plus \$5 office fee
- *Pole Exhibitions:* \$5

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

All horses being exhibited at the 2018 Nebraska State Fair must meet all of the equine health requirements, which are found at the following link: [2018 Equine and Equine Event Livestock Health Requirements](#). **Coggins (EIA) only out of state horses within 265 days of the Nebraska State Fair.
**Certificate of Vet Inspection (Health Certificate) with the Nebraska State Fair as destination.
**Rhino no more than four (4) months prior (120 days) to the FAIR. Will need to bring your proof of vaccination if you administer yourself.

DOGS

Due to requirements of the liability insurance carrier and policy of all major livestock shows, NO dogs are allowed on the Nebraska State Fairgrounds, in parking lots or in buildings other than those for direct competition or service animals. All dogs must be on a leash. There shall be no loose or unattended dogs on the fairgrounds. No dogs will be permitted in the animal barns, in tie outs or on the Midway, except during authorized events and sanctioned dog shows. Dogs entered in Nebraska State Fair special performances or competitive events will be allowed on grounds or in buildings during performance or competition only.

FEED AND BEDDING

*All feed and bedding needs will be handled by Mid Nebraska Feeds, which is the local Purina dealer. Hay, bedding and/or feed will be available. You can pre-order feed and bedding by contacting them at 308-382-3048.

SHOW RULES

1. Classes will be governed by the rules of [Equine Information, Rules and Regulations](#), [General Livestock Information, Rules and Regulations](#).
2. This will be ONE BIG RACE over two (2) days. We will do our best to get your run on the day that works best, but YOU MUST PRE-ENTER if you are making a request. NO EXCEPTIONS.
3. Pre-entries MUST be postmarked by August 15, 2018 and once the draw is posted there will be NO REFUNDS. You can sell you spot but it is YOUR RESPONSIBILITY to let the office know what changes have been made by 11:00 AM each day. NO EXCEPTIONS.
4. Returned check fee is \$50.00.
5. We encourage pre-entries to save time at the check in trailer.
6. **IMPORTANT** – FIRST 300 PRE-ENTRIES will run on their day of preference.
7. Late entries will be allowed until NOON and will run at the bottom of the draw. If running multiples horses, we will spread entries out as best we can in LATE DRAW. We will not fill slots and not trading with entries in the pre-draw.
8. No late entries allowed after NOON (12:00 pm).
9. MUST have horses name, NO horse 1 or horse 2 allowed. MUST run where you draw up.
10. You may substitute a horse but need to notify office ASAP.
11. Contestant has 60 seconds to get in the arena to make their run.
12. Three (3) call rule will apply, if not in the arena after the third (3rd) call, you will be disqualified.
13. A hit/knocked down barrel results in a NO TIME.
14. Broken pattern or loss of forward motion will result in a NO TIME.
15. In case of a tie, we will split the monies won and flip for the ties involving buckles or plaques.
16. No reruns will be given if horse falls, is pulled up by rider or tack malfunctions.
17. An electric timer will be used for all runs. In the event of a timer failure, a re-ride will be granted.
18. Big drag every 50 runs.
19. ANIMAL ABUSE WILL NOT BE TOLERATED. No excessive whipping, or spurs and NO strikes to the horse's ears, eyes or face with anything other than the hand, either in the arena or on the grounds will be tolerate. Abuse will result in a \$100 fine.
20. Dress code will be enforced. Western attire. NO jeans with holes or slits, collared shirts, cowboy hat or helmet and western boots. Keep backside covered during you runs please.

ARENAS

Shows will be held in the THOMPSON FOODS OPEN AIR ARENA.

A warm up arena provided will be provided.
