ENTRY FEES

Entry Fee: \$45.00 per head (this includes a \$15.00 bedding fee). This fee includes stall and tie out bedding. The first bedding will be provided for beef cattle exhibitors. Bulk bedding will be provided in the tie out area. Additional bedding may be purchased from Mid Nebraska Feeds at 308-382-3048.

AWARDS & PREMIUMS

1. This show is sanctioned by the Miniature Hereford Breeders Association.
2. Cattle entered must be registered in the Herd Book of the American Hereford Association. Polled and horned will show together in all classes. Entries with registrations pending, illegible tattoos or improper tattoos as shown on the registration certificate at check-in time are ineligible for competition. Maximum height at hip to be shown in these classes is 45" on mature females and 48" on mature bulls and steers. All entries will be measured at check-in. Those exceeding the height requirement will be disqualified from competition.
3. Entries are subject to provisions and rules for showing as set forth by the AHA Board of Directors and are subject to supervision of the Show and Sale Committee representing the MHBA.
4. All exhibitors must be current members of the MHBA in order to be eligible to show.

JUNIOR HEIFER AND STEER CLASSES

1. Cattle must be raised and handled in a humane manner. No added hormones, anabolic steroids or sub-therapeutic feed antibiotics can be applied / fed.
2. Any cattle entered in junior classes must be owned by exhibitor and registered with AHA in the exhibitor's name ONLY.
3. All entries must comply with the Livestock Health Requirements.
4. Ages: Must be 3 years of age by January 1, 2018 and have not yet turned 22 by January 1, 2018.
5. If necessary, classes will be divided according to weight after weigh in.
6. No premium will be paid for Junior classes.
