ENTRY FEES

Entry Fee: \$45.00 per head (this includes a \$15.00 bedding fee). This fee includes stall and tie out bedding. The first bedding will be provided for beef cattle exhibitors. Bulk bedding will be provided in the tie out area. Additional bedding may be purchased from Mid Nebraska Feeds at 308-382-3048.

GENERAL RULES

1. Entries are accepted with the understanding that each exhibitor agrees to conform to the Rules and Regulations of the RAAA. Enforcement will be at the discretion of the RAAA authorized representatives and may include barring an animal or exhibitor.
2. Exhibitors shall exhibit sportsmanship and professional behavior in and around the show ring. Abusive, discourteous or threatening behavior towards judges, show officials, fellow exhibitors or RAAA authorized representatives will not be tolerated.
3. All animals entered will:
 - a. Have at least one owner on record as a Regular or Junior Member of RAAA.
 - b. Be registered with RAAA and meet all requirements for Category 1A or 1B.
 - c. Have Official Registered Status at the time of processing.
4. Ownership requirements are also subject to the rules and regulations of the hosting exhibition.
5. Substitutions will only be permitted for animals already entered and within class, according to the hosting show's deadline, but no later than 10 business days prior to the date of processing.
6. All animals must have legible tattoos which match the Animal ID and Herd Prefix as recorded in the RAAA database prior to processing.
 - a. Animal ID and Herd Prefix verification may be via printed registration certificate or real time electronic representation of the RAAA database.
 - b. If the Animal ID and/or Herd Prefix are not legible and cannot be read during processing, it will be allowed to participate in the show. A fee of \$100 will be charged to the exhibitor for a DNA parentage test of said animal.
 - c. If the Animal ID and/or Herd Prefix are legible but are incorrect, the animal will not be allowed to show.
7. Each animal will be exhibited in its natural conformation and structure and without any alterations or modifications, with the exception of acceptable fitting and grooming practices.

8. The use of coloring agents, paints, and/or the addition of any hair or hair-like substances will not be allowed.
9. At the time of processing, all females 20 months of age or older on publicized date of show must have one of the following:
 - a. Certificate of pregnancy from a licensed veterinarian.
 - b. Written statement by a licensed veterinarian or embryologist of having produced fertile eggs.
 - c. Female's own natural born calf at side, which need not be registered, but must be eligible for category 1A or 1B registration in the RAAA.
10. All bulls 9 months of age or older on publicized date of show must be shown with a nose lead.
11. After processing, should the number of entries in any class exceed practicality, authorized representative of the RAAA shall have the authority to "split" classes according to age and at the date of birth that best encourages fair competition.
12. Any calf exhibited at the side of their dam in a cow/calf class may be exhibited in an individual class subject to all pertinent RAAA Show Rules and Regulations.

GROUPS

Groups are not eligible for Grand Champion.

No entry fee is required for groups.

Only two entries per exhibitor, per class are allowed for groups.

Each animal must be shown in an individual class to be eligible for a group class.

- 1464 **Produce-of-Dam:** Two animals by the same dam, either or both sexes, both shown in their respective classes. Animals shown in this class need not be owned by the exhibitor.
- 1466 **Senior Get-of-Sire:** Four animals by the same sire, both sexes represented, need not be owned by the exhibitor. All animals must have been shown in their respective classes.
- 1468 **Junior Get-of-Sire:** Three animals by the same sire, both sexes represented, need not be owned by the exhibitor. Entries must have been calved on or after September 1, 2017. All animals must have been shown in their respective classes.
- 1470 **Premier Breeder:** Will be computed from breeder's placement in individual classes only as follows: 3 points for each 1st; 2 points for each 2nd; 1 point for each 3rd. Maximum number of placements to be used to determine winner shall be limited to 5. Calculated on breeders of animals for exhibitors only. (In case of a tie, the next highest individual class placement will be used to determine the winner.)
- 1472 **Premier Exhibitor:** Will be computed from exhibitor's placement in individual classes only as follows: 3 points for each 1st; 2 points for each 2nd; 1 point for each 3rd. Maximum number of placements to be used to determine winner shall be limited to 5. (In case of a tie, the next highest individual class placement will be used to determine the winner.)
