

2018 Neewollah Dessert Contest Rules

“Neewollah Diamond Jubilee” Dessert contest

REGISTRATION and GENERAL INFORMATION

- All contestants must pre-register by submitting a completed entry form, a signed copy of the event rules, and pay the entry fee of \$5. payable to Neewollah Inc.
- Contestants may enter more than one dessert, but each additional dessert will require a separate entry form and entry fee.
- Please make sure to designate if the dessert needs to be “kept cold”. We will be able to place the dessert container on a bed of ice, but we do not have actual refrigeration available. Please plan your dessert entry accordingly.
- Entries need to follow the theme of Neewollah 2018 “Diamond Jubilee”. The completed entry form, signed rules and fee are due by Friday , October 19th. There are no mandatory ingredients, but all desserts must be baked.
- All desserts must be checked in at the Dessert Contest Tent promptly by 10:00a.m.

Neewollah Dessert Contest

- The public may purchase a choice of 3 sample-size desserts of their choice for \$2. The dessert sample sales will begin at 11:15 and will continue until 2:00 unless all dessert samples sell prior to that time.
- The Neewollah Chili Cook Off and Dessert Contest Chairpersons and committee members will NOT be responsible for lost, broken or damaged containers, non-edible decorations or serving utensils presented by the contestants.
 - all containers and non-edible decorations will be discarded unless otherwise indicated by the contestant during the dessert check-in process.
 - those contestants wanting their containers and/or non-edible decorations returned must have their name, address and phone number clearly labeled on the container.
 - All containers and/or non-edible decorations will be available for pickup at the Dessert Tent after 2:00 p.m.
 - Any containers and or non-edible decorations not claimed by 3:00 P.M. will be discarded.

Judging Criteria Information

- Judging of desserts will begin promptly at 10:30
- All dessert entries will be blind judged by a selected panel of community members.
- Dessert judging will be based on 3 criteria, each of which will be scored on a scale of 1-10. These scores when added together will give a final whole score. The desserts with the 3 highest scores will be deemed the 1st, 2nd and 3rd winners.
- In the event of a tie, a “taste off” will occur and the tie broken.

- The 3 judging criteria: Taste, Presentation, Difficulty and Creativeness.
 - Taste**: Above all else, taste is the most important factor.
 - Presentation**: The overall appearance of the dessert- does it look so good you can hardly wait to try a bite?
 - **Creativity**--does the dessert follow the Newollah theme?

Prizes

- 1st place \$100.
- 2nd place \$75.
- 3rd place \$25.
- Generalissimo’s Choice – *A surprise award determined by the Generalissimo*
- The first place winner will also have his/her name plate added (this will occur at a later date) to the Neewollah Dessert Contest perpetual trophy along with the previous years’ 1st prize winners. The trophy can be viewed at Neewollah Headquarters, while open for the 2019 season, and will be displayed on the Bandstand the day of the 2019 Neewollah Chili Cook Off.
