WHAT: 2019 NMSF Green Chile Cheeseburger Challenge

WHEN: Event – Monday, September 9<sup>th</sup> – in the afternoon

WHERE: The Agriculture Building Courtyard – New Mexico State Fair - ABQ

WHO: New Mexico restaurants are eligible. <u>Brick & mortar established restaurants only.</u>

## GUIDELINES AND PROCEDURES

- Participation is limited to **10** established [<u>brick-and-mortar</u>] restaurants that do business and pay taxes in New Mexico and are located within in New Mexico.
- If there are more than **10** entries, a drawing by lot will determine the contestants. If more than 10 contestants apply, names will be drawn out-of-a-hat on Tuesday, July **9th** to determine which restaurants will compete. The limitation of 10 is due to logistics for quality control.
- \*\* 1<sup>st</sup> PLACE WINNER and the PEOPLES CHOICE WINNER from the GCCC 2018, will have first-right-ofrefusal as an automatic "1<sup>st</sup>" entry. Should they choose to take advantage of this automatic buy, their entry must be received by the deadline.
- **NEW MENU RULE:** The winner of the 2019 NMSF Green Chile Cheese Burger Challenge is asked to feature that item on their menu, so their patrons can take advantage of purchasing the <u>1<sup>st</sup> Place</u> <u>Champion Burger from the Fair</u>.

If the menu already features that burger, we strongly encourage the winner to advertise that fact. If however the burger that won the competition is not a regular menu item, the NMSF **requires** that the <u>1<sup>st</sup> Place Burger</u> will be made available within two weeks of the competition and remain on the menu for one year beyond the September competition date.

- Entrants must provide their own cooking equipment and materials including grill, ingredients and a 10 X 10 canopy to cover the food prep area. **Canopies:** 'pop-up' tents must be made of a flame retardant fabric which includes the manufactures tag stating as such, please limit the size to 10'x10'. Additional details will be provided prior to competition.
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- *Not everyone* will need a canopy, however you must be prepared to have that item available.
- Each competitor will be allowed 4-5 personnel within the cooking area. They will be given gate passes for the day. At least one vehicle will also be allowed entry through Gate 6 for setup. The vehicle must be moved to the designated parking area before the competition
- Competitors are encouraged to decorate, promote and hand out any promotional information so the general public will know who is cooking and prepping for the contest. <u>We want all restaurants</u> to benefit from the competition and the promotion the New Mexico State Fair will be doing.
- Participants will be allowed access to the area as early as 6:00AM; on the day of the contest in order to be ready for inspections by appropriate health, and safety agency representatives. Inspections <u>start</u> <u>promptly at 10:00am.</u> {Monday, September 9}.

- An order to "*Fire Up Your Grill"* will be given at approximately 11:30am. This will allow contestants to "test cook" and prepare for the NMSF Green Chile Cheeseburger Challenge will occur. The contest will kick off approximately 12:00pm.
- Each participant will be notified in advance of the time when the judges will be *tasting* their entry. Contestants need be present for that announcement.
- Cooking will be done outdoors on the competitor's: Closed, self contained propane grill, with lid, within the confines of the competition area in the Agriculture Building Courtyard.
- The Fair will provide necessary fire extinguishers and trash receptacles. Cold water is available, at the 3 compartment sink inside the Agriculture Building.
- All patty cooking must be done on-site during the competition.

Once all competitors have finished presenting their respective burgers for judging and the on-site coordinator has cleared the competition complete, the "*People's Choice Competition*" will begin. An order to "Fire Up Your Grill" will be given for the PEOPLES CHOICE SAMPLING approximately at 1:30pm, this part of the contest will commence at 2:00pm. The NMSF will allow 125 - 150 ballots to be presented for the PEOPLES CHOICE SAMPLING.

- All ingredients must promote New Mexico agribusiness and include a meat or vegetable patty, cheese and <u>Green Chile</u>. Optional ingredients and any condiments may be used. Ingredients can be "premixed" and do not have to be disclosed.
- **<u>GREEN CHILE must be from a New Mexico home grown' location.</u> If you want to advertise the New Mexico farm or garden where the green chile was grown, that is permissible and encouraged.**
- Lineup/cooking position will be determined by lot, which will be done after all entrants have been chosen and qualified.
- A \$25 fee must accompany all applications and is non-refundable, even if not selected.
- <u>Entries must be received by:</u> <u>Monday, July 8th at end of business day.</u>
- If drawing is necessary, it will be held on Tuesday, July 9th and contestants will be notified after that time, via email and/or telephone.
- The competition area will be secured for the protection of the public.
- Judging will occur in the courtyard of the Agriculture Building in close proximity to the NMDA Country Store.
- TWO Individual complete burger must be delivered to judges who will sample portions at staggered times so they are hot and juicy. <u>The competition is just TWO complete burgers presented to the entry table.</u>
- The competition requires adherence to prevailing codes and rules of the New Mexico State Fair, the New Mexico State Fire Marshall and the New Mexico Environment Department. Any of the governing

entities have the authority to disqualify entrants if appropriate safety and health concerns are not followed.

• Fairgoers will be encouraged to watch the activities, but will be required to remain behind the border outlining the competition area. (In other words, the cooking and prep area will be inside a roped in and around the area).

Announcement of the winners; People's Choice and Awards Presentation will be made at the judges' podium in the Agriculture Building courtyard.

It is expected the announcement will be at approximately 4:00pm.

In the event of a tie, winner will be chosen based on the single score of the "Green Chile" category vote.
