New Mexico State Fair Ranked 3rd Most Affordable Fair in America

In a recent survey conducted by the travel website Hometogo.com, the New Mexico State Fair was ranked the 3rd most affordable fair in the United States. The survey, which was released earlier this week, based affordability upon six separate factors: parking, adult entry, child entry, an unlimited ride wristband, a regular corn dog, and hotel accommodation for one night.

The State Fair boasts extremely low admission prices, with adult tickets being \$10, and children's tickets being only \$7. Parking is also among the lowest expense, as Gate 8 offers parking for only \$5.

Unlimited ride wristbands are sold for \$35 during the fair, as the study reports. However, the New Mexico State Fair is currently offering the Mega Pass online for only \$28. Not only does this pass include one unlimited ride wristband, it also acts as an admission ticket into the fair. The Mega Pass is available at exponm.com until September 7.

One thing that the fair is known for is the spectacular food that is available for purchase. The New Mexico State Fair offers some of the most affordable food options to fairgoers, which is made even more reasonably priced with the introduction of the Graze Days promotion. On both Thursdays during the fair, September 6 and 13, between 11am and 4pm, all food vendors across the fair will have a special food item available for only \$3.
