Bring Two Non Perishable Food Items to the State Fair Tomorrow for Two Dollar Admission

In collaboration with Roadrunner Food Bank, tomorrow (Thursday, September 14) visitors to the New Mexico State Fair can help fight hunger by donating two canned foods or other non-perishable food items to receive discounted admission in exchange for their contribution. Between the hours of 10:00 AM and 5:00 PM, each person who brings two non perishable food items will receive a coupon for \$2 admission which can be used for entry on Thursday (only). The fair will only be collecting cans and distributing coupons up until 5:00 PM, so fairgoers will want to ensure they get their contributions in and receive their receipt before that time in order to take advantage of the \$2 admission offer. Otherwise regular admission prices apply tomorrow, which is \$10 per adult and \$7 for children and seniors.

Collection bins will be located at all entry gates (Gates 1, 4, 6, 8 and the Uber Gate). Donated items will be used locally and may also be shipped out in support of Hurricane Harvey and Irma relief efforts.
