



2019 NM Breeder's Classic Rules

Show: Sunday, September 8th, 2019 at 5pm at NM State Fairgrounds

1. **Ownership:** Steers and heifers must be owned by May 1, 2019 and managed under supervision of County Agent or Agricultural Education Advisor. Market Steers and Commercial Heifers must be tagged with NMSF ear tag by May 1, 2019 to be eligible for entry. Steers and heifers must have been continuously owned in the name of the exhibitor and personally cared for and may be transferred from 4-H Club to FFA or vice versa or within family during the feeding period. Bill of Sale must be available to be checked if requested.

Steers and heifers must be out of a New Mexico resident cow, but may be the result of artificial insemination or embryo transfer.

A copy of the New Mexico Livestock Board Form 1 will be required for steers and heifers. Heifers showing in breed classes will be required to present a copy of the appropriate breed registration form and meet the requirements of their individual breed association.

2. **Entries:** Entries must be postmarked by August 10th, 2019. Entries must be mailed to the NM Club Calf Association/NM Breeder's Classic, PO Box 26, Alamogordo, NM 88311. Entry Fee is \$35.00 per head. A W-9 will be required with paid entries. No late entries will be accepted.

3. **Arrival:** Animals must be entered to show in the NMSF in order to gain access to the state grounds. Entries must be on site by 6:00 p.m. Saturday, September 7th, 2019. Check-in and weigh-in will begin at 6:00 p.m.

4. **Show:** Steers and Heifers will be shown without any glue or paint. Any presence of any glue or paint like substance will result in immediate disqualification.

5. **T-shirts:** As part of entry fees, each exhibitor will receive a T-shirt at check in. Each exhibitor showing in the NM Breeder's Classic MUST wear the provided t-shirt for the show. This is to make sure the sponsors get the deserved recognition. NO EXCEPTIONS.

6. **Steers:** Steer classes will be broken by weight. At check-in all steers will be weighed. Steers will be eligible for a 5% weigh back at the discretion of NMCCA Board. A second weight will be granted upon request. Second weight will be the weight of record.

7. **Heifers:** Heifers will be broken in to the following breeds:

1. Hereford
2. Angus
3. Red Angus
4. Charolais or Charolais Composite
5. Simmental and Foundation Simmental
6. Brangus
7. Limousin and Lim-Flex
8. Brahman
9. Chianina
10. Maine-Anjou, Mainetainer
11. Santa Gertrudis
12. Sales
13. Shorthorn and Shorthorn Plus
14. American Lowline and Percentage Lowline
15. Commercial

Heifer classes will be broken at the discretion of the NMCCA board. Tattoos maybe checked on any heifer. Commercial heifer classes will be broken by weight. Commercial heifers will be eligible for a 5% weigh back at the discretion of the NMCCA board. Heifers must be born after Sept 1, 2017.
