Welcome State Fair Vendor:

You have been identified by the New Mexico State Fair Commission as a participant in this year's NM State Fair. As such, you are expected to comply with New Mexico Gross Receipts Tax (GRT) laws to report and to pay tax on the gross receipts of your business while at the State Fair. ***Failure to do so may impact your ability to return to the Fair in future years.***

If you are not registered as a New Mexico business, or if you are not approved to pay using your own CRS ID number, you will be expected to report and pay all applicable Gross Receipt Tax at the Taxation & Revenue Office on the Fair Grounds (directly across from Tingley Coliseum).

Our collection days at the 2019 State Fair are:

Monday, September 9th

Wednesday, September 11th

Friday, September 13th

Sunday, September 15th

Collection hours are 8:30 am to 4:00 pm each day.

If you are currently registered as a business in New Mexico and would like to report and pay your GRT using your own identification number you are required to obtain from Taxation & Revenue pre-approval to do so. Please e-mail your request to TRD.ABQSpecialEvent@state.nm.us upon receipt of this letter. Please include in your request your name, CRS ID number and your e-mail address. Your approval or denial will be returned to you by e-mail within ten working days. If approved, your CRS-1 reports should be e-filed on our new tax center (<https://tap.state.nm.us>) and payment will be expected in accordance to your CRS filing status.

Pre-approval requires that you be in good standing with the Taxation & Revenue Department (all reports filed and no outstanding liabilities).
