



* REPLACEMENT DAIRY HEIFER SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS *

*Entries open August 6th

*Entries close August 31st

*Video due at time of entry.

*Judging will be the week of September 14th

1. All exhibitors must be aged 9-18, as of January 1, 2020. All exhibitors will be allowed to show the animals that they had declared for the New Mexico State Fair.
2. There is no limit on number of entries allowed.
3. Animals can be fit to as if you were going to show for a traditional show, but is not required. Fitting Regulations are as follows: Absolutely NO artificial coloring, glues or adhesives will be allowed.
4. You will be required to enter the NMSF tag number of each entry you enter.
5. Replacement dairy heifers will be classified by age.
6. Registration is not required, but animals must show predominant breed characteristics. Sire and dam should be given.
7. In the event that not enough heifers are shown, breeds may be combined at the discretion of superintendent.

8. Replacement Dairy Heifer divisions offered at the New Mexico State Fair are as follows:

Junior Heifers

1. Spring Heifer Calf, born after January 1 of the current year
2. Winter Heifer Calf, born Nov. 1 - Dec. 31 of the prior year
3. Fall Heifer Calf, Sept. 1 - Oct. 31 of the prior year
4. Summer Yearling, born July 1 - August 31 of the prior year

Senior Heifers

5. Spring Yearling, born May 1 - June 30 of the prior year
6. Winter Yearling, born January 1 - April 30 of the prior year
7. Fall Yearling, born September 1 - December 31 two years prior
8. Heifers in class 6 & 7 **must be bred.**

A Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion Replacement Dairy Heifer will be selected.
