



Half Marathon

The NCSF half marathon road race will begin at 7:00, October 5th, on SR 1170, near the landing of the new Gallant's Channel Bridge. Parking areas for all ½ marathon and 10K competitors will be available in the parking lot near the new "Bonehenge" building. The first part of the race will run westbound on HWY70 and will require one lane to be closed for the entirety of the bridge. The route will continue on the westbound side for the Radio Island portion of HWY 70. The Route will then continue to utilize the westbound lane of HWY 70 over the Newport River Bridge and MHC Port area until the sidewalk becomes available in front of the Morehead City Yacht Basin until the race turns onto 4th street towards Bridges Street. The route will turn on Bridges Street and continue westbound until the route turns northbound onto 20th street. The route will follow along the sidewalk of 20th St. until it ends at the trailer park area, upon which the northbound lane will be used until the route turns onto Champion Dr. and Paulette Rd. to bring the route back to 20th St. northbound. The route will continue northbound on 20th street until it turns onto Blair Farm Parkway. The route will continue along Blair Farm Parkway, only taking a loop on Ivory Gull Dr. and will continue Blair Farm Parkway intersects Country Club Road. The route will briefly travel south until a walking path which connects Country Club Rd. to Lands Point Cul-de-sac. Continuing on Lands Pointe, the route will connect to the Country Club connecting road and eventually reconnect to Country Club Rd. southbound to connect to the earlier route on Blair Farm Parkway. From this point, the route will continue back towards Bridges Street in the same route that was taken to get to this point. Once the route back-tracks to Bridges St., the route will continue and cross over Arendell St. (HWY 70) and turn westbound onto Evans Street. When Evans St. intersects the Atlantic Beach Bridge, the route will travel on the Southbound lane towards the causeway. The route continues southbound on the Atlantic Beach Causeway until the route terminates in the parking lot area across from Sea Water Marina.



10 K

The NCSF 10 kilometer road race will begin at 7:30, October 5th, on SR 1170, near the landing of the new Gallant's Channel Bridge. Parking areas for all ½ marathon and 10K competitors will be available in the parking lot near the new "Bonehenge" building. The first part of the race will run westbound on HWY70 and will require one lane to be closed for the entirety of the bridge. The route will continue on the westbound side for the Radio Island portion of HWY 70. The Route will then continue to utilize the westbound lane of HWY 70 over the Newport River Bridge and MHC Port area until the sidewalk becomes available in front of the Morehead City Yacht Basin until the race turns onto 4th street towards Bridges Street. The route will turn on Bridges Street and continue westbound until the route turns northbound on 11th St., turns westbound on Bay St., Southbound on 12th St., and returns back to a westbound track on Bridges Street. The route will turn northbound on 17th St. and westbound on Bay St. When Bay St. terminates, the route will continue onto the boardwalk which traces the perimeter of Bay Watch Cemetery. This section connects to 20th St. where the route will then turn southbound to Bridges St and continue to cross over Arendell St. (HWY 70) and turn westbound onto Evans Street. When Evans St. intersects the Atlantic Beach Bridge, the route will travel on the Southbound lane towards the

causeway. The route continues southbound on the Atlantic Beach Causeway until the route terminates in the parking lot area across from Sea Water Marina.



5K

The North Carolina Seafood Festival 5 kilometer road race will begin at 7:30 am, October 5th, 3rd Street in down the waterfront to 4th Street, crossing Arendell St. (HWY 70) and eventually turn on Bridges Street and continue westbound until the route turns Southbound onto 20th street. The route will then turn southbound to Bridges St and continue to cross over Arendell St. (HWY 70) and turn westbound onto Evans Street. When Evans St. intersects the Atlantic Beach Bridge, the route will travel on the Southbound lane towards the causeway. The route continues southbound on the Atlantic Beach Causeway until the route terminates in the parking lot area across from Sea Water Marina.
