General Rules for Quilting

- **CHECKIN DATE & JUDGING DATE! See above**
- Entries must be the work of the exhibitor, completed since September 2017.
- Limit one entry per class per exhibitor
- **Must be 18 to enter, see Department 18 for youth entries.**
- No awards will be allowed for articles entered which have been purchased, received as a gift, or borrowed.
- All articles competing for premiums must be completed; otherwise, they will not be judged.
- Where there is no competition, or article has been incorrectly entered, judges may award first, second, third or nothing, according to the merits of the entry.
- Each entry will be eligible for best of show
- Definitions:
 - Mixed Media – combination of two or more techniques.
 - Novice: anyone who is just starting out in quilting.
- The judges reserve the option to withhold ribbons and awards in a class where there is no deserving entry.

Premiums and Special Awards

Premiums

Grand Champion: \$10 & rosette ribbon will be awarded to the “Best” entry in each department. “Best” is defined as the entry which demonstrates the best technique & skill.

1st place: \$5 & blue ribbon

2nd place: \$3 & red ribbon

3rd place: \$1 & white ribbon

Special Premium Awards

\$10 & a rosette ribbon and \$5 & a rosette ribbon will be awarded to the first and second entries that the judges determine warrant special recognition.

These awards are sponsored as follows:

Best Item Quilted by a Novice Quilter – ***Bear Paw Quilting & Bernina***

Best Quilted Holiday Item – ***Empire Airlines***

Washington State Quilter’s Award

The Washington State Quilters guild of Spokane, Washington will be awarding a cash prize of \$20 and ribbon to the first place winner and one additional ribbon for the second place winner. Prize money to be mailed after the fair concludes.

Quilts of any size, crib quilts or wall hangings in the Adult Open Division that show best work in construction, use of color and design and application of hand quilting or machine quilting stitches are eligible for this award. Whole cloth quilts are also included. All quilts must be owned by the exhibitor.

All quilts must be pieced/appliqued by the exhibitor and WSQ is allowing quilts that have been machine or hand quilted by others to be eligible for this award. A quilt that is entered with **all** work completed by the exhibitor should be given special consideration for this award.

North Idaho Quilter’s Award

The North Idaho Quilters Guild will award 1st place receives NIQ ribbon and \$20 cash prize, 2nd receives NIQ ribbon to each of the following: **Most Patriotic Quilt, Best use of hand embroidery or applique, Best use of machine embroidery or applique and Best Group Quilt.** Winners will be determined based on work on construction, use of color and design, and application of hand or machine quilting. Prize money to be mailed after the fair concludes.

Inland Northwest Machine Quilter’s Award

Inland Northwest Machine Quilters guild of Spokane, Washington will be awarding one Best of Show Machine Quilting ribbon with a \$25 cash award and one Honorable Mention ribbon to the Machine Quilters. Prize money to be mailed after the fair concludes.

Quilts of any size or style in the Adult Open Division that is machine quilted, either professionally or by the quilt maker are eligible for the award.

Superintendent’s Award

A special rosette ribbon will be awarded to the entry that merits special recognition by the department superintendent. It does not need to be a placing entry.

Themed Contest

A special rosette ribbon will be awarded to the winner in this class determined by the judge. Emphasis is placed on entries with the best use of current fair theme. **(Class 67)**

What the Judges look for with Quilts

- **GENERAL APPEARANCE:** Total impact, neat & clean, square & flat
- **DESIGN:** Choice & use of color & pattern for top & borders, suitability of materials to design & function, originality or use of traditional pattern
- **WORKMANSHIP:** Precision of cutting, stitching & finishing, quilting techniques, binding & edging

LIMIT ONE ENTRY PER EXHIBITOR

Entry can be any item that is described in this department but cannot be entered in any other class.

Entry must be prepared according to the General Instructions listed at the beginning of this department as well as any other instructions contained within.

Entry must have an index card (measuring no larger than 4" x 6") securely attached that explains in 100 words or less the material's previous life. Explanation must be typed or legibly printed. Do NOT put your name on this card.

Placing entries in each division will receive a special green ribbon.

- "Novice" refers to anyone who is just starting out in quilting.
- Exhibitor can enter in this or any other section in this department.
- Anyone who has entered in prior Fairs in this or any other section is not considered a novice and should not enter in this section.
- Any technique can be used.
