General Rules for Fine Arts

- Art accepted at the Superintendent's discretion.
- Limit one entry per class per exhibitor.
- **Must be 18 to enter, unless otherwise noted. See Department 18 for Junior Arts.**
- Entries must be original in concept and execution, the work of the exhibitor, completed within the last two years, and not entered in previous North Idaho Fairs.
- **Maximum sizes:** Due to space limitations, oversized works will not be accepted.
 - **36" x 36" – MAX Size**
- **PAPER & CANVAS BOARD MUST BE FRAMED.**
- **STRETCH CANVAS is acceptable without framing IF the edges are painted.**
- **ALL ENTRIES must have SCREW EYES AND WIRE for hanging already installed. *We are not responsible for damage due to improper hanging installation.**
- If framed, glass or plexiglass must be placed over watercolors, pastels and drawings.
- Prints may not be photo-mechanically reproduced.
- **Entry tag must indicate type of medium used.**
- **Each entry must have a title for the art.**
- Judging will be by qualified judges of the fine arts. The option is reserved to withhold ribbons and awards in a class where there is no deserving entry.
- "Novice" refers to anyone who is just starting out in Fine Arts and should enter in the Novice Artist section only.
- Exceptionally fragile work cannot be accepted.
- No tape, strings, rope of any kind.

Premiums and Special Awards

Premiums

Grand Champion: \$10 & a rosette ribbon will be awarded to the best entry as determined by the judges. "Best" is defined as that which demonstrates the best technique and skill.

1st place: \$5 & blue ribbon

2nd place: \$3 & red ribbon

3rd place: \$1 & white ribbon

Special Premium Awards

\$10 & a rosette ribbon and \$5 & a rosette ribbon will be awarded to the first and second entries that the judges determine warrant special recognition. These awards are sponsored by:

Superintendent's Award

A special rosette ribbon will be awarded to the entry that merits special recognition by the department superintendent. It does not need to be a placing entry.

What the Judges look for in Fine Arts

- **GENERAL APPEARANCE:** Neat, clean, finishing techniques suitable to subject & medium
- **WORKMANSHIP:** Techniques correct & consistent, composition balanced
- **CREATIVITY & SUITABILITY:** Originality or presentation of subject, choice of color combinations, medium & techniques suitable to subject, difficulty of project

NOVICE ARTIST

- “Novice” refers to anyone who is just starting out in Fine Arts.
- A novice artist cannot enter in any other divisions or classes.
- Anyone who has entered in prior Fairs in any other section is not considered a novice and should not enter in this section.
- Open to Aspiring Young Professionals ages 13-17. **Youth entering in this Division 16C CANNOT cross enter Youth Division 18U.**
- Art is subject to superintendent approval and may be moved to the Youth Department at their discretion. Must have proper hanging hardware. No tape, strings or rope accepted.
