### General Rules for General Crafts

- Entries must be the work of the exhibitor, completed since September 2018.
- **MUST be 18 to enter, youth entries see Department 18**
- Limit **one** entry per class per exhibitor
- Only completed items will be judged.
- **Items made with plastic canvas must be entered in Department 13-General Crafts or Department 18-Youth.**
- No awards will be allowed for articles entered which have been purchased, received as a gift, or borrowed.
- Where there is no competition, or article has been incorrectly entered, judges may award first, second, third or nothing, according to the merits of the entry. Judges shall not award prizes to unworthy entries.
- The judges reserve the option to withhold ribbons and awards in a class where there is no deserving entry.

**NEW**

We invite all community members to get involved so we want to offer that opportunity without the nerves and intimidation that potential exhibitors may have.

When updating your personal information please make note if you could be considered an exhibitor in the special needs/other circumstances category, or are a first time exhibitor. We won't request any information, but trust that exhibitors are mindful and honest when entering. Exhibits will still be entered in classes listed with the limit of one entry per class; however, they will also be judged for top special entry and top first time entry.

### What the Judges look for with Crafts

- **GENERAL APPEARANCE:** Neat, clean, well balanced, finishing techniques enhance finished item
- **WORKMANSHIP:** Consistent use of proper techniques, attention to detail, neatness of work (paint applied evenly & cleanly, no visible glue, etc.), balance of design & color, finishing techniques well done, workmanship appropriate to age of exhibitor.

- **SUITABILITY OF DESIGN, COLOR, CONSTRUCTION MATERIALS:** Originality/creativity of design, choice of materials, pleasing color combinations, type of materials appropriate to use of finished item
- **DIFFICULTY OF PROJECT**

#### EMBELLISHED READY-MADE ITEMS

- "Embellished" refers to ironed on appliqué, painted on appliqué, glued beading or sequins, and/or textile painting.
- Items embellished with machine stitched appliqué or embroidery, or hand-sewn beading should be entered in Department 7, Sewing.

#### FLEECE & FABRIC PROJECTS - NOT SEWN

- SEWN items are to be entered in Department 7, Sewing

### PAPER TOLE/3D DECOUPAGE

- Frame must be equipped with screw eyes and wire for hanging.

### **What the Judges look for in Paper Tole/3D Decoupage**

**WORKMANSHIP:** Precision cutting. Each piece must be separated, shaped and reassembled. Creative and realistic shaping with no cracked edges; Nicely rounded and colored edges. All glue and other means of elevation hidden from view, no gaps visible.

- **LAYERS:** Background, middle ground, and foreground should be kept in perspective. The background should have less emphasis than the foreground.
- **FRAMING:** Free from debris inside the frame. Complementary mats and frames, with a professional looking finish.

### **What the Judges look for in Scrapbooking**

- **JOURNALING, SOUVENIRS & KEEPSAKES PHOTOS:** photo placement, quality of pictures, how the pictures relate to each other

- 66 Scrapbooking, heritage (50s & earlier) single sheet
- 67 Scrapbooking, collage or shabby chic, single sheet

##### What the Judges look for with Miniatures

- **CONSISTENCY TO SCALE**

##### CLASS

##### MODELS

- **MAXIMUM CREATION SIZE** is 22 inches wide by 14 inches deep by 12 inches tall.

##### What the Judges look for in Models

- **PAINT JOB:** Models will score higher with paint job than those without; decals should be neat; all parts of the car should be painted or chromed, except tires.
- **ASSEMBLY:** Lack of glue smears & paint blobs, parts fit, parts belong to model.
- **FEASIBILITY:** If this model was full sized, could it be operated? Drive-shaft should be connected to engine on car model.
- **DETAILS:** Engine wiring, compartment detail, paint & chrome, underside of model cars should be painted.
