### **General Rules for Needlecrafting**

- Entries must be the work of the exhibitor, completed since September 2018.
- Limit **one** entry per class per exhibitor
- **Must be 18 to enter.**  
**Youth register in Department 18, but enter exhibits in Building 19.**
- All articles competing for premiums must be completed; otherwise, they will not be judged.
- **Items made with plastic canvas must be entered in Department 13-General Crafts or Department 18-Children's Crafts.**
- No awards will be allowed for articles entered which have been purchased, received as a gift, or borrowed.
- Where there is no competition, or article has been incorrectly entered, judges may award first, second, third or nothing, according to the merits of the entry. Judges shall not award prizes to unworthy entries.
- The judges reserve the option to withhold ribbons and awards in a class where there is no deserving entry.

**NEW** We invite all community members to get involved so we want to offer that opportunity without the nerves and intimidation that potential exhibitors may have.

When updating your personal information please make note if you could be considered an exhibitor in the special needs/other circumstances category. We won't request any information, but trust that exhibitors are mindful and honest when entering. Exhibits will still be entered in classes listed with the limit of one entry per class; however, they will also be judged for top special entry.

### **What the Judge looks for in Needlecrafting**

- **OVERALL APPEARANCE:** All needlework will be judged with regard to beauty, degree of perfection, amount of work and suitability for the purpose for which it is intended. Entry must be neat, clean, properly blocked, finished appropriate to pattern & function (frame, pillow blocking, etc.). If an entry is soiled or there are mistakes in the pattern, it could be disqualified by the judges.
- **SUITABILITY OF DESIGN, COLOR, THREAD/YARN:** Choice & color of thread or yarn, canvas or fabric type, appropriate to pattern & function. Color selection & quality of yarn will NOT be judged.
- **WORKMANSHIP:** Stitches made correctly, tension even (no distortion of hole & fabric), stitches smooth & flat (no twisted threads), backstitching straight & even, no visible carry-overs from reverse side.
