General Rules for Photography

- Entries must be the work of the exhibitor, completed since September 2018.
- Limit **one** entry per class per exhibitor
- **Must be 18 to enter, see Department 18 for Youth entries.**
- Exhibitor's name, address, phone number, class and title of entry must be on the back of each print.
- **Prints in frames will not be accepted**
- **NO Foam Board**
- **ALLOWED ENTRY SIZES: (except Class 31)**
- Adult division: one 8"x10" print with an 11"x14" mat

NEW We invite all community members to get involved so we want to offer that opportunity without the nerves and intimidation that potential exhibitors may have.

When updating your personal information please make note if you could be considered an exhibitor in the special needs/other circumstances category, or are a first time exhibitor. We won't request any information, but trust that exhibitors are mindful and honest when entering. Exhibits will still be entered in classes listed with the limit of one entry per class; however, they will also be judged for top special entry and top first time entry.

What the Judge looks for in Photography

- **OVERALL APPEARANCE:** Clean, photo securely attached to mat, mat color & style enhances the photo
- **TECHNIQUE:** Focus, lighting, color balance, depth of field, angle, quality of developing & printing
- **COMPOSITION:** Photo captures the mood/spirit/life of the subject so viewer knows more about the subject after looking at the photo, balance of elements (subject the most prominent element of photo & background does not detract from subject)

CHOICE OF SUBJECT

DEFINITIONS

- Babies: birth to 2 years old
- Children: 2 to 16 years old

- Still Life: inanimate objects
- Skyscapes: sunrises, sunsets, etc.
- Action scenes: such as sporting events
- Architecture: buildings, bridges, monuments, etc.
