Fairest of the Fair

The purpose of the Fairest of the Fair program is to promote the enormous variety of opportunities – educational, agricultural, social, cultural and commercial – available at the Northern Wisconsin State Fair.

If you are selected as Northern Wisconsin State Fair Fairest of the Fair, you are the official ambassador of the Fair and will represent the Northern Wisconsin State Fair at various activities throughout the year. You will compete at the Wisconsin State Fairest of the Fair competition to be held in early January at Chula Vista in Wisconsin Dells. You could become the next Wisconsin State Fairest of the Fair representing all Fairs in the State of Wisconsin.

If selected as the 2019 Northern Wisconsin State Fair Fairest of the Fair, you will work with the Fairest committee to attend events and functions throughout our community. A schedule of appearances will be provided to you at a later date. The Fairest term is for one year, from the date of coronation, January 12, 2019 through the 2020 Wisconsin Association of Fairs - Fairest competition.

The following skills are essential to perform the duties of Fairest. You must be devoted to the Fair, poised, mature, out-going, articulate, and sensitive to all types of people. You may be required to be out in the elements for long hours while being pleasant to guests. With reference to the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), please let us know if you will need accommodations, such as reasonable modifications or adjustments for this process.

You must be able to adapt to any situation and be dependable and professional in the performance of your duties. Appropriate cell phone and social networking etiquette should be maintained at all times during your role as Fairest of the Fair. The position will be challenging and as rewarding as you make it. We seek candidates who are exemplary in their line of study and who have a passion for the Fair, continued education and service to our community.

Compensation to the Fairest is a \$1,000 continuing education scholarship from the Northern Wisconsin State Fair Association, Inc. To receive this scholarship, you must complete a semester of college level school and present your passing grade report for the first semester and proof of enrollment for the following semester. Upon completion and provided to the Fair office, a check will be issued to you and the school you are attending. This continuing educational scholarship may be postponed for 2 years with approval by the Northern Wisconsin State Fair Association.

Fairest of the Fair Program Obligations, Rules and Requirements

Please read the following carefully. By signing this sheet you are agreeing to comply with the rules as set by the Northern Wisconsin State Fair *Fairest of the Fair* Committee and the Northern Wisconsin State Fair Association.

1. Contestants are required to attend the coronation ceremony on January 12th, 2019 held at Avalon Hotel & Conference Center, Chippewa Falls, WI (business professional attire required).
2. The Contest is open to individuals who have been a resident of the State of Wisconsin for at least one year prior to entry.
3. Contestant must be 18 years of age as of January 1st, 2019.
4. Contestant must have a valid Wisconsin driver's license with a good driving record.
5. Contestant may not have been convicted of a felony.
6. A contestant must reside in Chippewa County; or they may reside in an adjoining county if they have previously participated at the Northern Wisconsin State Fair.
7. The time, manner and method of judging will be decided by the Northern Wisconsin State Fair *Fairest of the Fair* Committee. The decision of the judges is final.
8. There will be preliminary evaluation of applications by the Northern Wisconsin State Fair *Fairest of the Fair* Committee. Those that advance from the preliminary will be notified.
9. Contestants must have a prepared and memorized 30-second self-introduction. Contestants will be asked to present this at the *Fairest of the Fair* competition.
10. Contestants must have a prepared 30-second radio advertisement promoting the Northern Wisconsin State Fair. This ad should be spoken and not sung. Contestants will present this during the *Fairest of the Fair* competition.
11. The winner of the Northern Wisconsin State Fair *Fairest of the Fair* competition will be required to compete in the Wisconsin Association of Fairs *Fairest of the Fair* competition in January 2020.
12. Should the winner not be able to fulfill his/her obligations, the first runner-up will assume the duties of the Northern Wisconsin State Fair *Fairest of the Fair*.
13. Specific duties may be assigned to the winner at various events throughout the year as well as at the Northern Wisconsin State Fair in July 2019.
14. If you are not selected as the Northern Wisconsin *Fairest of the Fair* you will be allowed to run again. A contestant may run up to two times (does not have to be consecutive).
