## HORSE AREA RULES

### PLEASE REMEMBER...

You and your horse are here as an exhibit for the general public. Please take pride in your horse and the appearance of the barn and grounds.

- **Please include the following information on your stall**
  - Name and cell phone number
  - Horse's name
  - Veterinarian's name and number
- Please check with your 4-H Leader or Superintendent to see what day you are scheduled to help out with the daily horse show activities. **If you are not registered with a group you must check with the Horse Superintendent on Saturday for your assignment.**

### BARN RULES

1. No cross tying or stall guards allowed
2. Bedding is required in your horse's stall
3. No hay nets. Hay bags are okay and opening must be above the horse's withers for safety.
4. No smoking or vaping in barns or tents.
5. Dogs must be on a leash at all times and are not allowed in the horse barn or horse tent
6. Aisles must be kept clear
7. **No horses allowed in center aisle**
8. 8. Manure must be put in designated areaHorses are to be fed between 6:30 am and 7:30 am
9. **Water and stalls are to be maintained at all times. Two buckets are recommended.**
10. There will be a nightly check at 10:00 pm and other random times. Superintendents and Fairboard will monitor proper care and maintenance of the animal and assigned housing.
11. Lights out in the barn and tent at 11:00 pm
12. **NO HORSES allowed designated "ho horse" areasProper footwear must be worn at all times when working with your horse (NO flip-flops)**
13. Any posted additional rules shall be followed.

## GENERAL RULES

1. Checkout times are per the Fairbook and occur in the morning only. See the Daily Horse Schedule.  
All requests for late arrival/early departure must be submitted by the exhibitor for review by the Rules Committee before June 3, 2019.
2. Stalls and barn are to be kept clean at all times. Stalls are to be thoroughly stripped and cleaned and VERIFIED by the SUPERINTENDENT before departure.
3. No non-exhibitor is allowed on a horse without the permission of the Horse Superintendent.
4. All horses must be led to and from all rings, practice and make-up arenas.
5. No lunging in any arenas when there are riders present. No loose horses in any arena.
6. **PARENTS/TRAINERS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO COACH ANY EXHIBITOR WHILE THE CLASS IS IN PROGRESS.**
7. All exhibitors and parents MUST review and be familiar with all applicable General Rules, Horse Rules and Barn Rules in the Fairbook. Lack of familiarity with the rules will not be accepted as an excuse if the rules are violated.

**I HAVE READ AND AGREE TO COMPLY WITH THE ABOVE RULES and understand that violation of any of these rules may result in loss of premium and/or I may be asked to leave the premises. I understand that submitting this verification form does not enter an exhibitor in the Fair. Each exhibitor must register for all applicable classes and pay all required entry fees to be considered an exhibitor at the Oakland County Fair.**
