2019 Small Car Rules

Okeechobee County Fair · Sunday, March 17th 2019

RULES

ANY YEAR, NO EXCLUSIONS.

- Can be any foreign or domestic 2 or 4 door hard top car (no open roofs) or station wagon. 4 or 6 cylinder only.
- Maximum wheel base is 107"
- Car body or station wagon only. No SUVs or cross overs.
- All cars need to have (1) working fire extinguisher.
- Driver seat belt must be in working order and be used.
- Long pants and long sleeves with a helmet and safety eyewear, if not a full faced helmet.
- Remove all glass, plastic and moldings. WINDSHIELDS CAN REMAIN IF NOT BROKEN. If windshield are removed, at least (1) safety bar or chain is required.
- Remove all passenger seats.
- Batteries need to be relocated to passenger floor.
- All car entries must have identifying numbers or name (family appropriate) on both sides of the car for identification and must be large enough for the announcer to see.
- All body parts and frames are to remain stock, unless specifically specified in the rules.
- Cars must remain stock.
- Hood and trunks must have a 10" x 10" hole cut out in the center for fire safety.
- Suspension must remain stock and have bounce.
- Any tire allowed.
- Weld or wire doors 5" on and 5" off. No other welding other than welding stock bumper on.
- BUMPERS MUST BE STOCK AND ORIGINAL TO CAR; INCLUDING THE YEAR. No bumper skins.
- 4 Bar Floating Cage

THIS IS A BONE STOCK DERBY, IF IT DOES NOT SAY IT, DOESN'T MEAN YOU CAN DO IT!
