

Valentine's Day Popcorn Balls

Ingredients:

- 1 bag of marshmallows (approx. 10 oz)
- ½ cup butter (1 stick)
- 1 tsp vanilla
- Popped popcorn
- Food coloring (pink or red) (optional)
- 1 cup M&Ms or other candy
- Non-stick baking spray

Directions:

- 1. Preheat oven to 200 degrees. Spray 9x13 baking dish with non-stick spray or coat with butter.
- 2. Pop enough popcorn to fill 9x13 baking dish. Pop a couple extra cups to add to mix if needed. (Make sure to keep the popcorn warm in the oven while completing the following steps)
- 3. Melt the butter and marshmallows together in large pot. Once fully melted, turn off heat.
- 4. Add the vanilla and food coloring.
- 5. Pull baking dish full of popcorn out of the oven. Drizzle the marshmallow and butter mixture over the popcorn.
- 6. Use your hands or wooden spoon to mix up the popcorn and marshmallow mixture until the popcorn is evenly coated. (If using your hands, coat with baking spray or butter to keep mixture from sticking) Cool slightly and add M&Ms. (If not cooled, the M&Ms will melt and turn popcorn balls brown)
- 7. Recoat your hands and grab a handful of popcorn and start forming it into a ball. You will need to squeeze firmly while making the balls. Make them any size you want.
- 8. Wrap I plastic wrap or bag them up.
