Parmesan Chicken Casserole

Ingredients:

- 6 boneless, skinless chicken breast (diced)
- 1 cup mayonnaise (or Greek yogurt)
- 1 cup shredded parmesan cheese
- 1 tsp seasoning salt
- ½ tsp ground black pepper
- 1 tsp garlic powder

Directions:

1. In a small bowl, combine the mayonnaise, ¾ cup Parmesan, seasoning salt, black pepper, and garlic powder. Set aside.
2. Place diced chicken into greased 9 x 13 baking pan.
3. Spread mayonnaise mixture evenly over top of the chicken.
4. Sprinkle remaining Parmesan cheese on top of mayonnaise mixture.
5. Place baking pan in preheated oven, 375 degrees, and bake for 30-35 minutes.
6. Remove from oven and serve over pasta, rice or by itself.
