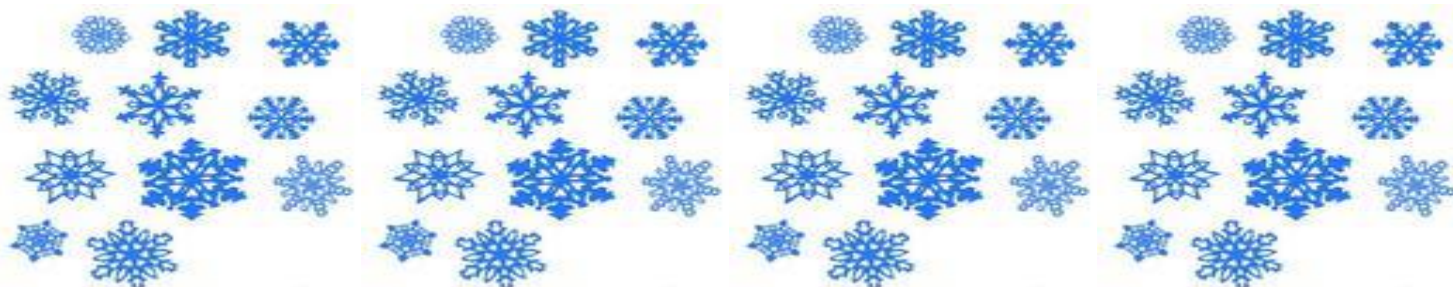
## Black-Eyed Peas and Little Smokies with Cabbage
