RULES & REGULATIONS FOR SWAP MEET

NO VEHICLE TRAFFIC PERMITTED FROM 9AM TILL 4PM
ALL VEHICLES AND PARTS MUST BE REMOVED BY 9PM SATURDAY

General Rules, Policies and Springfield City Ordinances:

- NO Parking, loading or unloading at anytime in Fire Lanes.
- Illegally parked vehicles will be towed at owners expense.
- NO Camping on site.
- NO motor vehicles driven between 9am and 4pm - NO bicycles, skates, skateboards or scooters.
- Wheelchairs and handicap scooters that are allowed by ADA can be used on property. Their speed not to exceed 5 mph. NO Golf Carts, ATV, Side by Sides, or UTV allowed.
- Vendors are not allowed to give away or sell refreshments; food or beverages, by Springfield Ordinance.
- NO Sales of firearms permitted by Springfield Ordinance.
- Alcoholic beverages are permitted only in designated area on site.
- ALL pets and service animals must be on a leash at all times.
- The Ozark Empire Fairgrounds and the Swap Meet are NOT responsible for accidents and/or theft.

Vendor Information:

Vendor Load-in starts Thursday May 20 at 8am till 8pm - ALL Gates LOCKED at 9pm.

Vendors are able to get onto the grounds Friday, Saturday & Sunday starting at 7am till 9am

- Vendors can exit the Fairgrounds starting at 4pm till 6pm on Friday and Saturday.
- ALL Gates will be LOCKED at 7pm Friday & Saturday

- You MUST present ID at check in to get your parking/vendor passes
- 80% of your items must be auto related.
- Windshield card must be clearly displayed on left corner of windshield/dash.
You will NOT be permitted into the Fairgrounds without this card on your windshield!
- All vehicles must be IN your purchased spaces.
- Car Corral vehicles must-have card on at all times.
- Riding around the inside of the Swap Meet is NOT permitted.
- Any vendor who sets up or rents a tent 400 sq ft or larger (i.e. 20 ft x 20 ft), the tent supplier must obtain a permit including any required fire department inspections.
- Gates will close 10pm Saturday May 22. Anything left on Fairgrounds will become property of Ozark Empire Fairgrounds and disposed of as we see fit.

Car Corral Rules & Policies

- NO parts are to be displayed or sold in the Car Corral. Parts that belong with the vehicle being sold must be inside the vehicle or on the trailer with it.
- Car Corral vehicles must have stickers on them at all times.
- NO riding around the inside of the Fairgrounds
- Vehicles MUST be removed by 10pm Saturday May 22, or become property of the Ozark Empire Fairgrounds

Public Admission times

- Gates open to the public at 8AM and are locked/close at 7PM Friday and Saturday.
