- The objective of Lead Line is to showcase to the public methods of modern sheep production and to promote the use of wool by demonstrating its source, versatility and beauty.
- Entries in this class are open to young men and women between the ages of 8 and 22 years of age who are sponsored by an exhibitor of breeding sheep at the Ozark Empire Fair. **Age will be determined as of July 1, 2017.**
- Entrants must wear garments made of wool or wool material not exceeding 30 percent synthetic blend. Judging is based on the exhibitor's poise and grooming. Apparel will be evaluated on its style, practicality, the quality of the wool, the attractiveness of the entire ensemble and how well it showcases the beauty of wool.
- The ewe will be judged on conformation, grooming and responsiveness to handling. Decoration may be used on the ewe.
- Sheep must be registered yearling ewes or ewe lambs conditioned and fitted for show and trained to lead at halter. All sheep must show in their respective breed classes. All livestock rules for showing sheep at the Ozark Empire Fair will apply.
