REGULATIONS - Standard and Bantam

- Coop charge is \$1.50 per bird. Double coops may be available with an additional \$1.50 fee if indicated on entry.
- ENTRY DEADLINE IS JULY 1.** All entries must be postmarked by this date. **No late entries accepted.**
- Complete all information as requested on entry form using sex-age code and class number. Please mark Frizzled or not for applicable entries.
- Each exhibitor will be sent admission credentials for bringing and picking up entries. Please use Gate 10. An official release slip must accompany entries leaving the grounds. Anyone leaving before release time will forfeit all prize money won and the right to further participation.
- Competition is open to the world but, due to space limitations, entries will be limited to the first 300 birds.
- All birds except waterfowl must be pullorum-typhoid tested as per MO Department of Agriculture regulations. See Livestock Entry Rules.
- Each bird must wear a numbered leg or wing band.
- PRIZE MONEY:** 1st = \$3; 2nd = \$2; 3rd = \$1. Prize money will NOT be paid unless there are at least two entries in the class. An exhibitor may not win more than two monies per class. Prize Money awarded to individual classes only, not group.
- All entries will be judged to fifth place by the latest edition of the **ABA & APA Standard.**

- ** Animals must be exhibited in individual classes to be eligible for group classes.**
- SHOWROOM MANAGEMENT:** Greatest care will be taken of all exhibits, but Ozark Empire Fair will not be responsible for any accident, mistake, loss or damage, regardless of cause. No one except those in charge of show and judge will be allowed to handle birds on exhibition without consent of owner or superintendent.
- A card will be furnished for the variety name and the name of the owner. Card will be opened after judging. No advertising matter will be allowed without permission of the superintendent.
- No poultry may be removed from the premises until release on Saturday evening.**

Junior Division: Classes are offered for all youth who are 8 years of age as of July 1, but not over 22 years of age as of July 1. Please check Junior on Entry Form. OEF will not be verifying whether exhibitors are members of 4-H or FFA. However, membership is strongly encouraged. Out-of-state entries will be accepted. All entries will NOT be automatically entered into the open show. **Junior exhibitors must enter their birds in both the open and junior classes. Junior classes use the same class numbers as the Open Division, simply add a 'Y' in front of the open class number.**

AWARDS - Standard and Bantam

- DISPLAY AWARDS:** \$5 for best display in each section provided there are at least two competing displays in that section. Display is seven birds of the same variety entered by one exhibitor. Display must include one cock, one hen, one cockerel and one pullet. The three remaining birds may be any age or sex. All birds in a display must be entered in the show.
Winner will be determined by points won. (1st = 5 pts., 2nd = 4 pts., 3rd = 3 pts., 4th = 2 pts., 5th = 1 pt.) Points will be multiplied by the number of entries in that variety.
- BEST OF BREED:** \$10 for Best of Breed in all breeds with 20 or more birds shown. Reserve Best of Breed: \$5.
- BEST OF VARIETY:** \$10 for Best of Variety in all varieties with 10 or more birds shown. Reserve Best of Variety: \$5
- ABA & APA AWARDS:** Only paid members in good standing of the ABA or APA are eligible for club awards.
Fair premiums will not be based on ABA/APA membership.
