The Pasadena Livestock Show and Rodeo Association (PLS&R) is proud to announce their 32nd Annual Beauty Pageant Competition on Saturday, October 10, 2020. Competition winners will have the opportunity to represent the Pasadena Rodeo in the Grand Entry, parades, and other youth and family events. The competition will be held at the Texas Chiropractic College in the Iwama Auditorium. Competitions are open to females up to 24 years of age and to contestants from surrounding areas. You must never have been married, given birth, adopted (making you a parent), or plan on being married, giving birth, or adopting within the reigning year. Proof of age is required for all age divisions. Each contestant under the age of 18 will be required to have a parent or legal guardian present the day of pageant registration.

COMPETITION INFORMATION

INTRODUCTIONS: This year's competition will consist of introductions for Young,

Junior, Teen, and Miss Pasadena Rodeo contestants. This will give contestants an opportunity to introduce themselves to the judges.

The attire for this is interview wear.

Introductions are not for Baby, Tiny, Little, and Petite Miss

Pasadena Rodeo.

ATTIRE: Attire for the onstage modeling competition portion must be

evening gown and western wear for Young, Junior, Teen and Miss divisions. Variations might be dressy rodeo wear or fancy western shirts, jeans, skirts, dresses, and accessories. Contestants may wear

hats, vests, or boots. No props, please.

The Baby, Tiny, Little and Petite divisions will wear their own

version of western wear. No props, please.

MODELING: Modeling will be a "T" shape formation, entering from the middle

of the back stage. As for modeling styles, the contestants may do their choice of poses on stage. Girls under the age of 5 may be accompanied by an adult on stage. Following each contestant's individual onstage modeling, please line up backstage for a



divisional "final look" on stage for the judges to finalize their scores before proceeding back to the dressing room.

PHOTOGENIC ENTRIES:

There are two optional photogenic categories. One will be beauty evaluation, called Photogenic. The other will be western wear theme, called Photogenic Western Wear. These categories require a submission of one photo for the category. If a contestant chooses to submit additional pictures (more than the 1 allotted photo) within the category, a \$10 fee for each additional photo will apply. These photos must be turned in no later than 5 PM Friday, October 2, 2020 and may be delivered directly to the Pasadena Rodeo office. These pictures MUST be unframed and labeled on the back with the contestant's name, age division, and the photogenic category in which to be entered. If the photo is not unframed and not labeled, it will not be judged. Size 8x10 photos only please. The PLS&R and beauty pageant committee are not responsible for pictures not picked up during registration on the day of the pageant. Pictures will not be mailed back to the contestant. The photographs entered will be judged prior to the day of the pageant, and will be returned during registration on Saturday morning.

PORTFOLIO:

Portfolio is another photographic category option. A portfolio is a book of photos, consisting of no more than ten (10) 8x10 photos of the contestant that differ from Photogenic and Photogenic Western Wear categories. A ½ inch or 1 inch binder with page protectors is the preferred format for the portfolio. Portfolios must be turned in to the Rodeo Office no later than 5 PM Friday, October 2, 2020. The first page of the portfolio should be devoted to labeling the portfolio and should include the contestant's name and age division. The portfolio entered will be judged prior to the day of the pageant, and will be returned during registration. The PLS&R and beauty pageant committee are not responsible for portfolios not picked up during registration on the day of the pageant. Portfolios will not be mailed back to the contestant.

TOP MODEL:

Top Model is an optional entry. Each girl will receive a 5 minute photo shoot. Winner will be chosen on modeling skills, personality and a naturally photogenic contestant. You will receive a CD with your unedited photos. Attire is outfit of choice. There will be one overall winner.



SPOKESMODEL: Spokesmodel is an optional entry. Contestants will prepare a video

speech to deliver to the judges via Dropbox. Time limit is 60 seconds. Choose the topic of your choice. Interview attire is recommended. Once registered, a Dropbox Link will be sent to upload your video submission. There will be one overall winner for Baby, Tiny, Little & Petite Miss age divisions and one overall

winner for Young. Junior, Teen & Miss age divisions).

TALENT: Talent is an optional entry. Each video entry will have a 2 minute

30 seconds limit. Points will be deducted for exceeding time limit. Once registered, a Dropbox Link will be sent to upload your video submission. There will be one overall winner for Baby, Tiny, Little & Petite Miss age divisions and one overall winner for

Young. Junior, Teen & Miss age divisions.

DRESSING

ROOMS: Dressing rooms are provided inside the auditorium. Please do not

leave any valuables unattended when departing from the dressing room area. PLS&R is not responsible for any lost or stolen items. No men are allowed in the dressing area. Due to limited space occupancy, only <u>one</u> chaperone will be allotted per contestant.

PHOTOGRAPHY: No flash photography will be allowed. A professional

photographer will take pictures of the contestants during each age division competition. No cameras on tri-pods will be allowed. Spectators are not permitted behind the judges for photos or to

coach the contestants while on stage.

CONDUCT: Inappropriate conduct by contestants or their supporters will not be

tolerated and could result in disqualification. No coaching from the audience will be allowed. Unsportsmanlike conduct could result in expulsion. Contestants are expected to be punctual. Those who are not may be subject to disqualification as determined by the General Chairman and Assistant General Chairman.

PAST WINNERS: Under no circumstances will a contestant be allowed to compete in

an age division the contestant has previously won. The 2019 Queens of age divisions Young Miss Pasadena Rodeo, Junior Miss Pasadena Rodeo, Teen Miss Pasadena Rodeo, and Miss Pasadena Rodeo will be invited to share their final walk and to crown the

2020 winner of their respective age division.

JUDGES: Judges will be highly qualified in beauty, arts, talent, and/or

community involvement. If a contestant and a judge are found to have any affiliation, the contestant will be disqualified. Judges are



informed of the contestants prior to the pageant to ensure that there is no bias. It is requested that there be no contact with judges before, during or after any competition.

DUTIES OF THE QUEENS:

The contestants that win their age division will be invited to represent the Pasadena Livestock Show and Rodeo at several events such as the Pasadena Rodeo Grand Entry and the Pasadena Rodeo Parade among others, to be determined. You are expected to maintain the look you received your title with throughout the year. If the winner of the age group is unable to be present, the first runner up may be asked to make the appearance instead as determined by the General Chairman and Assistant General Chairman. Though our queens ages 8 and under are encouraged to attend events, this applies to queens ages 9 and older.

SPONSORS:

A contestant may obtain business or family sponsorships. The Pasadena Livestock Show and Rodeo Association is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization; therefore, sponsorship is tax deductible. If a contestant does obtain a sponsor, please include the name/business name on the Master of Ceremonies (Emcee) sheet so the sponsor can be properly recognized.

ORIENTATION & REHEARSAL:

The orientation meeting is for all contestants and will be held on Thursday, August 20, 2020 at 6:30 PM in the Pasadena Rodeo Director's Room. This meeting is designed to answer any questions, turn in entry forms/pay fees and provide modeling advice from former winners.

There will be a rehearsal for contestants at Texas Chiropractic College in the auditorium the night before the pageant on Friday, October 9th.

PAPERWORK & DEADLINES:

Please complete the Entry and Hold Harmless Agreement forms, as well as create the master of ceremonies sheet so that the contestant (Baby, Tiny, Little & Petite) can be properly announced during the pageant. To avoid late fees, all forms and payments must be post marked (if mailed) or brought to the Rodeo Office by 5 PM Friday, October 2, 2020.

A non-refundable late fee of \$30 will be applied to paperwork that is turned in or post-marked after 5 PM October 5, 2020. We will continue to accept late entries until Wednesday, October 7, 2020 at 5 PM. NO ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER 5 PM, WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 7TH. All forms should be typed for legible reading. The emcees will read the master of ceremonies sheet directly as it was written and submitted while the contestant is on stage. An example of this can be found listed online with the other paperwork.

PAGEANT

COMMITTEE: No relative of any pageant contestant will be allowed to serve on

the beauty pageant committee.

AWARDS AND INFORMATION

SCORE SHEETS: In order to protect the privacy of all contestants, master scores will

not be displayed. Individual score sheets will be available upon request immediately following the contestant's division crowning ceremony. The PLS&R **WILL NOT** release scores after the event. If the contestant wants to know how they scored, they must be requested via email at plsrbeautypageant@gmail.com the week of Monday, October 12th through Friday, October 16th. Scores will

not be released after 5 pm Friday, October 16, 2020.

INTERVIEW: There will be a brief interview for the contestants competing for

Young, Junior, Teen Miss Pasadena Rodeo and Miss Pasadena Rodeo. This will be held before the on-stage presentation in a room with only the panel of judges and a beauty pageant representative. The judges will receive your Contestant Bio before you enter and

will base their age appropriate questions according to your



community involvement, activities, character, and current events. The interview will be exactly 7 minutes long, with an additional 30 second closing. Attire for this is business casual. Contestants who are tardy or who discuss the questions asked in the interviews with attendees or other contestants may be subject to disqualification as determined by the General Chairman.

SCORING:

All contestants are judged in five categories: beauty, modeling, fashion, personality, and overall. These are all judged by the contestant's performance on stage. Each category is scored 1-10 points and all portions are weighted equally into the on-stage score.

Contestants competing for Young Miss Pasadena Rodeo, Junior Miss Pasadena Rodeo, Teen Miss Pasadena Rodeo and Miss Pasadena Rodeo will have 15% of their score from introductions (made to judges), 50% of their score from their on-stage performance in their evening gown and western wear and 35% from their interview.

People's Choice, Talent, Spokesmodel, Top Model, Photogenic and Photogenic Western Wear optional photo judging scores **DO NOT** count toward the on-stage presentation given by the contestant, and are judged by a separate panel of qualified judges.

An auditor will be present during the competition and will verify all judging tabulations to ensure accuracy of competition.

TIES:

In the event of a tie for the categories of beauty, modeling, fashion, and personality, the tie will be broken by a random sequence generator. In the event of a tie for the winner, 1st and 2nd runner ups, the judges will break the tie.

MISS PASADENA RODEO:

There is a \$1,000 award available to the accredited college or university of choice for the contestant that is awarded Miss Pasadena Rodeo. Contestants eligible for this award include high school seniors, dual credit students, college students, and women 18-24 years of age. The former Teen Miss Pasadena Rodeo is also eligible for this award, regardless of her age, only if she chooses to compete in the Miss division. The scholarship will be given at the end of the reigning year upon providing verification to PLS&R of successful completion of studies. The 1st runner up to Miss Pasadena Rodeo will receive a \$350 award available to the accredited college of her choice. The 2nd Runner up will receive a



\$150 award available to the accredited college of her choice. 1st and 2nd Runner up award monies can be redeemed the week following the pageant with proof of enrollment. For award money distribution, please contact Office Manager, Sherry Free.

AWARDS:

Prizes will vary with age and appropriateness. The queen in each age division will receive a crown, satin sash, a queen's plaque, gift bag, flowers, and a crown pin. 1st and 2nd runner ups will receive a plaque and sash. We will award winner's sashes for the following awards:
