Pasadena Livestock Show and Rodeo Livestock Commitment and After Auction Sale Rules



- 1. The sale of exhibits sold by commitment will be handled through the Pasadena Livestock Show and Rodeo Offices. **ALL SALES ARE FINAL**. ALL exhibitors MUST have met all livestock rules to be eligible.
- Each exhibitor will be responsible to feed and care for the animal for the duration of the Rodeo until
 the animal is released from the Livestock barn on the Sunday morning after the show ends. Any
 animal sold in the auction is NOT eligible for a commitment.
- 3. Commitment forms will be accepted via the website (www.pasadenarodeo.com) beginning August 1, 2018 and will not be accepted after Tuesday, September 25, 2018. Forms will be accepted on a first come, first served basis. Completion of a form does not guarantee purchase of the animal requested.
- 4. If an exhibitor has an exhibit which does not make the Auction, an exhibit which the exhibitor does not have a sponsor/buyer for and the exhibitor would like for the PLS&R to try and sell this exhibit in the Commitment Sale or After Auction Sale, the exhibitor must fill out a Sale Form. Sale forms will be available on the PLS&R website (www.pasadenarodeo.com).
- 5. The Sale Forms must be turned in to the Livestock Show Office no later than close of business on Tuesday, September 25, 2018, except for steers which must be turned in by noon, Wednesday, September 26, 2018. Steers will not be sold in the Commitment Sale.
- 6. Once a Show Sale form has been submitted for an exhibit, the **entry is final and the exhibit may not** be removed from the sale process.
- 7. Exhibitors, please be advised that there is **NO GUARANTEE OF SALE** in the Commitment or After Auction Sale.
- 8. Exhibitors are responsible for making sure the sale animal gets to the destination. Trailers for the processors will be on site on the day animals are released from the Livestock barn. Exhibitors are responsible for loading their exhibit. If your exhibit is to be delivered to the buyer, you must call and make arrangements for delivery. Remember to get a Proof of Delivery Form signed when you deliver the animal.
- 9. Exhibitors' checks will be ready for pick-up by the exhibitor (signature required) no later than December 30, 2018. A proof of delivery form (if applicable), a completed W9 form and a copy of the thank you letter to the Buyer MUST be received in the PLSR office before check will be issued.
