The friendly and generous reception and entertainment of guests, visitors, or strangers.

This category will be judged based on the cook team's interactions with the PLS&R Office, the PLS&R volunteers and the public.

A selected committee will speak with the PLS&R Office personnel, a cross section of volunteers that interact with the cook teams (ex. Team Reps, Ice Committee, Band, trash...) and will walk the grounds observing the members of the cook team.

1. Defined –Noun-

Skill at entertaining, theatrical presentation, or performance.

Attendance

A select group of judges will be on the grounds observing every cook team. The identity of the judges will not be known by the cook teams; they will not present themselves as judges. The group will see how well is the cook area decorated, is there a theme, is there entertainment (a band, a DJ, etc.) and what kind of attendance was present. The judges may pass Thursday, Friday and Saturday of the cook off.
