

## **RULE 34: HEIFER SHOW**

- a. Heifers must be purebred with a registration certificate from the breed association and born after April 1, 2016. Heifers must be at least 4 months old to show.
- b. Animals entered must be owned by the exhibitor and registered in the records of the respective breed association (in the name of the exhibitor) on or before August 1, 2018. Permanent identification (i.e. brand or tattoo) must be present and must match the registration paper of the animal.
- c. Entry fee, entry form and registration certificate must be mailed to the PLS&R office (attention: Livestock Secretary) and postmarked by midnight September 10, 2018.
- d. There will be no family ownership of heifers. Exhibitors may show more than one heifer.
- e. See Rule 28 for specific grooming rules. Soap and water only may be used for grooming prior to entering the Show ring. Any exhibit which shows evidence of artificial coloring except hoof dressing on hooves and dew claws, will be disqualified.
- f. For safety purposes, a wild or unruly heifer may be disqualified from showing.
- g. All heifers must have a **neck tie and halter** on them when they are in the in the livestock barn.
- h. Check in for heifers will be Tuesday, September 25, 2018 between 7 AM and 9 AM Judging will begin at 10 AM. Heifers will be released after judging and must be removed from show barn by 10 PM Tuesday, September 25, 2018.
- i. An Overall Grand Champion and an Overall Reserve Champion will be chosen, but will not be sold in the Livestock Auction or the After Auction Sale.
- j. Heifers will be shown in the following divisions:  
  
American Breeds  
British Breeds  
European or Exotic Breeds
- k. Classes for each division will be: \*\*  
  
Class 1.....January and after, 2018  
Class 2.....September through December, 2017  
Class 3.....May through August, 2017  
Class 4.....January through April, 2017  
Class 5.....September through December, 2016  
Class 6.....April through August, 2016

\*\*The Chairman has the right to combine breeds, if insufficient in number, and create a class or classes if deemed necessary.\*\*
