*The Youth Exhibits operate under the General Rules and Regulations of the 2020 Pasco County Fair. The General Rules and Regulations are available upon request.*

**ELIGIBILITY:**

1. All Pasco County School Students (Grades PK-12)
2. All exhibits must be the work of the exhibitor.
3. No soiled or incomplete articles will be accepted.
4. All exhibits must have been completed since the 2020 Pasco County Fair and not exhibited before at this fair.

**ENTRY PROCEDURES:**

1. Participants may exhibit only one item in each class of a category but may enter all classes of the category. It is not necessary to have more than one item entered in a category to win.
2. Each exhibit must have a 2” x 3” label/card placed on the article that includes:
  - a. Exhibitor's Name
  - b. Email or Phone to Contact
  - c. School or Organization
  - d. Grade Level
  - e. Category

**REGISTRATION & DROP OFF:**

1. Articles entered for exhibition in the 2020 Youth Exhibit will be received at the fairgrounds in the school building on:  
Friday Feb. 14<sup>TH</sup>, between 1 and 4 pm.  
Saturday, Feb. 15<sup>TH</sup>, between 10 am. & Noon

**BAKED GOODS SHOULD BE REGISTERED AND DELIVERED ON SATURDAY, FEB. 15<sup>TH</sup> BETWEEN 10 A.M. AND NOON.**

**JUDGING & RIBBONS:**

1. Ribbons will be awarded according to the discretion of the judges. An award will be given for the **OUTSTANDING EXHIBIT** in categories according to the discretion of judges.

**Pre-K - Pre-Kindergarten**

**Primary - Kindergarten thru 2nd Grade**

**Intermediate - 3rd thru 5th Grade**

**Middle School - 6th thru 8th Grade**

**High School - 9th thru 12th Grade**

**\*Special Education students will receive awards at their grade in all categories listed.**

**CATEGORY I – PASCO COUNTY FAIR 2020 THEMED**

Anything related to or associated with The Pasco County Fair or “IT’S AN ADVENTURE”

**CATEGORY II – ORIGINAL ART**

Painting (oil, acrylic, watercolor, etc), three (3)-dimensional art form, graphics (poster, block printing), mixed media, photography, finger painting, pencil, charcoal, pastels, markers, gel pens, crayon, fibers, tie-dying, batik, weaving, clay, computer art, wood burning, miscellaneous art.

**CATEGORY III – HOME LIVING ART**

Pillows, doll, toys, jewelry, ornaments, decoration, sewing, knitting, cross stitch, macramé, string art, quilts, duct-tape, leather, houseplants.

**CATEGORY IV – ORIGINAL LITERATURE**

Poetry, a short story or paragraphs (on poster or single sheet of paper).

**CATEGORY V – MATH OR SCIENCE**

Geometric Shapes or designs, Biology, Chemistry, Physics, Balance, Magnets, miscellaneous Science.

**CATEGORY VI – TECHNOLOGY OR INVENTIONS** Anything that required a computer or other technology to create printed on paper or 3-D printer. Original inventions with explanations.

**CATEGORY VII – BUILDING AND MACHINES**

Models, Ships, Planes, Buildings, Miniature Construction, Lego

**CATEGORY VIII – OUR WORLD**

Displays that show our environment or the world around us, anything created from recycled products, sand art, wood or metal.

**CATEGORY IX – COLLECTIONS**

Each collection must have been by the individual exhibiting it. Collections must be properly labeled, if possible, (common name, scientific name, date) and/or other pertinent information. Collection must be self-contained (notebook or display box). Collections may not exceed 3 square feet. Collections that were entered previously must show that their contents have increased 25% over the previous year. Example: 100 stamps exhibited last year must have a minimum of 125 stamps to be eligible this year. EX. Rocks, bones, bugs, leaves, shells, coins, stamps, sports cards miscellaneous.

**CATEGORY X – HOME COOKING\*\***

- CLASS A – Cakes (2 slices, not whole cake)
- CLASS B – 3 Cookies
- CLASS C – 3 Muffins
- CLASS D – Quick Breads- 3 Slices
- CLASS E – Pie - 1 slice

- CLASS F – Brownies – 3
- CLASS G – Yeast Bread or 3 rolls
- CLASS H – Candy – 6 pieces
- CLASS I – Cupcakes – 3
- CLASS J – Jam/Jellies
- CLASS K – Miscellaneous

***\*\*Recipes are required for all classes on a 3 x 5 card. Please bring entries on disposable plates. Food entries are disposed of at the conclusion of the fair.***

***ALL WORK MUST BE PREPARED & SUITABLE FOR DISPLAYS.***

**Not every entry will get a ribbon for each display. There will be a first place for every category.**
