Code.

The Pendleton Round-Up and Happy Canyon will provide you with –

- A positive and rewarding experience that allows you to be a part of the historic Pendleton Round-Up and Happy Canyon show.
- Necessary orientation and any specialized training for specific jobs such as LBR and Goldie's bartenders, security volunteers, ticket takers, ushering, etc.
- An open and friendly environment where every volunteer is encouraged to approach any Board of Directors member with ideas, problems and concerns.

We ask that you please,

- Be an active part of our teams and attend any necessary training classes offered for your volunteer positions.
- Conduct yourself in an **appropriate** and ethical manner at all times when dealing with our visitors', contestants, volunteers, staff, animals and Board Members.
- Please be safe! If you see any unsafe conditions, anyone damaging our facilities, or endangering any animal please report it to our security personnel immediately.

What is unacceptable as a PRU/HC Volunteer:

- Verbal or physical harassment of any sort, any profane or abusive language to visitors, contestants, staff, animals or fellow volunteers.
- Any violence or threat of violence to any individual or animal.
- Any theft from visitors, volunteers, Happy Canyon Co. or the Round-Up Association.
- ***Any of the above can and will result in your immediate removal from our properties and loss of your future volunteer status for both the R-Up and HC.***
