#### How to Get to Wells Park at 98 Oak Street in Brewster, NY:

- Take a Metro-North train to the Brewster Train station. It is a 10 minute walk to Wells Park
- We anticipate that Wells Park parking lot will fill up quickly - but fear not! Parking is available at the following Brewster locations:
  - Gold lot\* located in between the Brewster Library and the Studio Around the Corner at 67 Main Street.
  - Tristate Commuter Lot\* is on Park Street and Morningthorpe Ave
  - LAZ Parking on Railroad Avenue

- Garden Street school at 20 Garden St.
- Village DPW/PD Lot at the Corner of Peaceable Hill and Main Street
- Anne Koplik back parking lot at 173 Main Street
- Trolley service courtesy of Putnam County will be available and will loop through all the event parking locations and the train station.
