All entries shown in the Dairy Goat classes will be subject to the General Rules and Regulations of the Rio Grande Valley Livestock Show and in addition, the following rules and regulations:

1. Each exhibitor must be a member of a 4-H Club or FFA Chapter and be enrolled in elementary, secondary or home school in Cameron, Hidalgo, Starr or Willacy County and in their respective FFA Chapter or 4-H Club from November 1, 2018, through the Show period.
2. Exhibitors must be in third grade or nine years old but under 20 years of age as of January 1, 2019.
3. All goats must be the bona fide property of the exhibitor and continuously fed and cared for by the exhibitor from November 30, 2018, thru Show date under the supervision of an AST, CEA or adult 4-H Leader. **OMIT FOR 2019 SHOW**
4. Goats entered in this division cannot be shown in the Market Goat Division.
5. Exhibitors will not be limited to the number of entries they can enter.
6. Abnormalities: Goats showing any pronounced defect, abnormality or open wounds will be barred from showing. Any evidence of cosmetic surgical alteration to enhance the physical conformation of an animal or dying of hair will disqualify the entry.
7. Fitting guidelines: Goats may be fully haired or trimmed to the owner's discretion.
8. Goats will be shown by the age on the Registration Certificate in the following order.

9. Training collars may be permitted during sift or during judging at the discretion of parent, 4-H Leader or FFA Advisor for the safety of exhibitor.

Dairy goats are shown in different categories (listed below)

1. Junior Division: does(females): That are under 24 months old and have never been bred
 - a. Junior kids: under 4 months old
 - b. Senior kids: 4-8 months old
 - c. Junior yearlings: 8-12 months old
 - d. Senior yearlings: 12-24 months old

CHAMPION AND RESERVE CHAMPION JUNIOR are selected from these classes and then can compete for show champion

2. Senior Division: does (females) that are over 24 months old or have freshened
 - a. Under two years
 - b. Two years and under three years
 - c. Three years and under 5 years
 - d. 5 years and over

CHAMPION AND RESERVE CHAMPION JUNIOR are selected from these classes and then can compete for show champion
