## RULES

1. Entry and Fees due Friday, May 17, 2019
2. Entry Fee: \$1.00 per entry. The correct entry fee MUST accompany each entry form
3. Exhibits Received: Wednesday, June 19, 2019 2:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m.
4. Animals Released: June 23, 2019 after 3:30 p.m.
5. **If an animal is removed between 11:00 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. without written permission from the Fairgrounds Management, the exhibitor will not be allowed to exhibit any animal at the 2020 Redwood Acres Fair AND they will lose all money earned at the 2019 Redwood Acres Fair.** Exhibitors must at all times give the necessary attention to whatever they have on exhibition in the Rabbit & Cavy Department. The exhibitors MUST FEED AND KEEP THEIR ANIMALS CLEAN and in show condition. Cage must be kept clean.
6. NOTE: Exhibitors must furnish feed for their animals. Rabbits & Cavy must be fed, watered and have their pen cleaned daily (more often if needed) before the opening time of the fair.
7. Positively no breeding of rabbits at the show.
8. NO exhibitor will be allowed to bring animals into the showroom to be offered for sale that are not officially entered in the Fair.
9. Exhibitors are to furnish their own food and water containers.
10. **UNIFORM:** The required dress for this event is the traditional white pants, and white shirts. You may not show unless in uniform.
11. For breed Lots there is no limit on entries.
12. **LIMIT:** 1 ENTRY PER EXHIBITOR PER LOT
