The 2020 Rock County 4-H Fair has been cancelled due to community health concerns related to COVID-19 and the Rock County Fairgrounds serving as a COVID-19 Isolation Center.

The safety of Rock County 4-H Fair visitors and the surrounding community is our highest priority. Our plans for a scaled-down fair were approved by the Rock County Health Department but are not possible given new information about the COVID-19 Isolation Center footprint which extends beyond Craig Center to a majority of the fairgrounds.

As community leaders, we support the well-being of our county and understand that the COVID-19 Isolation Center takes precedence.

We are heartbroken about the disappointment and inconvenience this causes you, our livestock and competitive exhibit participants. You are the heartbeat of the fair and the reason the fair is the highest regarded annual showcase of all that's exceptional about Rock County. We know you have worked tirelessly to prepare your livestock, projects and entries. Although this is not the decision or the outcome we'd hoped for, the fair must do its part to improve community health and safety and reduce the cycle of infection.

Provided the COVID-19 situation improves to the point where it's safe to hold mass gatherings, the Rock County 4-H Fair will return July 27-August 1, 2021.
