### **Market Calf Guidelines:**

1. Entries must give breed, name, sex, birth date, correct division and Class.
2. Must be owned by the exhibitor for 60 days prior to the opening day of the fair. Proof of ownership will be a bill of sale or a signed statement and project book showing the animals were dropped from the exhibitors' cow and were raised by the exhibitor.
3. Weight range shall be 250 to 400 pounds. Animals weighing more than 400 pounds will be moved to the Feeder Beef classes and will not be eligible for the Auction...
4. Grooming and show ring requirements will be the same as Market Steers. Use of show stick is required.
5. Feed: Grain, Hay and Nutritional Formulas. (Please check in the general livestock rules for the nurse animal qualifications.)
6. **Market Calves must be a minimum of 50% Dairy.**
7. **All Market Calves MUST be dehorned (No Scurs) and castrated. Dehorned (No Scurs) if Heifers**

### Market Calf Scorecard

**Group 1:** Smooth, deep, thick and compact, with superior and above conformation.

**Group 2:** Must possess a moderately high degree of the qualities of higher grades, carry less finish and show more bone and less uniformity.

**Group 3:** Lack finish and are rather leggy and hippy, rough in the shoulder and light in the round. This group will not be sold at auction.

All lambs will be checked at weigh-in for compliance of the Tail Docking Rule according to California Div. of Fairs and Expositions State Rules.

**Not Market Ready:** Good or lower quality grade with 12th back fat range < .08 or > .22; Underfinished goats grading USDA good or lower, below average conformation or cutability

Rules:

Goats must show kid teeth.

All goats must be dehorned, may have 2" scur

## \*Master Showmanship\*

We will offer Master Showmanship Competitions for each of the showmanship classes.

The 1st place winner, of each of the classes, in each specie, will be given the opportunity to compete in the Master Showmanship Contest. Each specie contest winner must declare to the Livestock Office, **ONE HOUR AFTER** their species has shown, his or her intentions of competitions. If their intentions are not declared the Livestock Office will offer the next placed specie contestant.

**The winner of each showmanship class will bring the animal that they used in showmanship to the master showmanship contest.  
They will not be allowed to use their own animal in the contest.**

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## Voluntary Livestock Evaluation Contest

This contest is designed to be a rate of gain as well as a carcass evaluation (using the Ultrasound equipment) competition and educational program. Livestock Evaluation is a program to provide junior exhibitors a learning experience that emphasizes all aspects of production. It is used to evaluate the total product rather than just the live animal as it appears on show day. This contest objective is to reward those exhibitors that produce an exceptional product through good selection, proficiency through healthy feeding practices and good livestock project management.

### **Evaluation Contest Scoring Procedure**

Using data obtained from weighing steers, lambs, hogs and goats at + - 60 days, then getting a final weight and ultra-sounding for loin-eye and back fat thickness at the fair, animals are scored for the evaluation contest in the following manner:

#### **Average Daily Gain – 40%**

Calculated by dividing pounds gained by the number of days (60 or 120). Most pounds per day scores highest or 40 points, 2nd 36 points, etc.

#### **Loin-Eye Size – 40%**

Measured in square inches using actual ultra-sound data. Largest scores highest or 40 points, 2nd 36 points etc.

#### **Fat Thickness – 10%**

Measured in inches using ultra-sound data.

In hogs and lambs, least scores the highest and in beef the most scores highest or 10 points.

#### **Show Placing – 10%**

Calculated using show ring placing. 1st place scores 10 points, 2nd scores 9 points, etc.

Entries in the Livestock Evaluation Contest will register and be weighed and ear tagged at the San Bernardino County Fair Fairgrounds, unless otherwise listed, on the dates listed below.

### **Guidelines:**

1. Entry Fees: Beef: \$20.00 per head  
Swine, Sheep, & Goat: \$12.00 per head
2. All animals entered in the Market Steer, Sheep, Goat and Swine division are eligible to participate in this division.
3. All local and state rules apply.
4. To enter, exhibitors must complete the following:
  - A. Weigh animals and pay evaluation entry fee at official pre-weigh day
  - B. Enter the animal in a regular market division and pay the regular market entry fee by **April 23, 2020**
  - C. Weigh-in during weigh-in day.
  - D. Have the animal evaluated by the ultrasound technicians at the designated time
  - E. Show the animal during the Live Evaluation Class.
5. Exhibitors must be present to the show their own animal. Official uniform is required.
6. Placing in this division will not affect the sale order.
7. The specie jackpot monies may be divided between 3<sup>rd</sup> through 10<sup>th</sup> place or further if specie monies allow.
8. **Each class must have at least 5 entries** to receive pay out

6. Jackpot monies minus show expenses and special award expenses will all be paid out on a percentage based on the number of show entries.
7. **Jackpot or premiums to be paid out only if shows expenses have been covered.**
8. Show awards if money allows.
