Not Market Ready Steers: Market Steers lacking evidence of sufficient fat deposition to produce a desirable consumer product. Steers projected to grade USDA Select- or lower.

Market Calf Guidelines:

1. Entries must give breed, name, sex, birth date, correct division and Class.
2. Must be owned by the exhibitor for 60 days prior to the opening day of the fair. Proof of ownership will be a bill of sale or a signed statement and project book showing the animals were dropped from the exhibitors' cow and were raised by the exhibitor.
3. Weight range shall be 250 to 400 pounds. Animals weighing more than 400 pounds will be moved to the Feeder Beef classes and will not be eligible for the Auction...
4. Grooming and show ring requirements will be the same as Market Steers. Use of show stick is required.
5. Feed: Grain, Hay and Nutritional Formulas. (Please check in the general livestock rules for the nurse animal qualifications.)
6. **Market Calves must be a minimum of 50% Dairy.**
7. **All Market Calves MUST be dehorned (No Scurs) and castrated. Dehorned (No Scurs) if Heifers**

Market Calf Scorecard

Group 1: Smooth, deep, thick and compact, with superior and above conformation.

Group 2: Must possess a moderately high degree of the qualities of higher grades, carry less finish and show more bone and less uniformity.

Group 3: Lack finish and are rather leggy and hippy, rough in the shoulder and light in the round. This group will not be sold at auction.

Any hog of below average conformation including U.S. No. 3, U.S. No. 4 and utility grade hogs.

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SBCF Dairy Replacement

Heifer Program

1. **Entry Fee: \$10 per entry**
2. Must be a breed suitable for commercial dairy milking purposes (i.e.: Holstein, Jersey, or crossbreds)
3. Must be owned by the exhibitor for a minimum of 90 days prior to the opening day of the fair in which the heifer is shown as a yearling. Proof of ownership will be a bill of sale or a signed statement and project book showing the animal was dropped from the exhibitor's cow and raised by the exhibitor.
4. All cattle must be de-horned, from a herd that is not infected with tuberculosis, and bear evidence of official calf hood vaccination against brucellosis.
5. To be eligible to sell your heifer at the San Bernardino County Fair Auction you *must* show your heifer at the San Bernardino County Fair for 2 years – 1st year as a yearling and 2nd year as a bred heifer. It is preferred that the heifer is due to freshen at or around fair time.
6. Sale heifers must have proof of pregnancy age as verified by a licensed veterinarian or fair management designee.
7. Exhibitors may only sell 1 heifer per year in the San Bernardino County Fair Auction.
8. In the event that the heifer freshens during the fair and before the auction, the heifer and calf will be sold as a pair.

ALL BREEDING LIVESTOCK MUST BE CHECKED IN 24 HOURS PRIOR TO THE DAY OF SHOW.

Not Market Ready Lambs: Good or lower quality grade with 12th rib back fat range < .16 or > .35; under finished lambs grading USDA good or lower, below average conformation or cut ability.

Rules:

Lambs must show lambs teeth.

All lambs will be checked at weigh-in for compliance of the Tail Docking Rule according to California Div. of Fairs and Expositions State Rules.

Market Goat (Chevon) Scorecard

Market Ready Goat: USDA prime or Choice quality with 12th rib back fat range .08 - .12 most desirable, .13 - .22 back fat acceptable, average of greater conformation and cutability.

Not Market Ready: Good or lower quality grade with 12th back fat range <.08 or >.22; Underfinished goats grading USDA good or lower, below average conformation or cutability

Rules:

Goats must show kid teeth.

All goats must be dehorned, may have 2" scur

Open to San Bernardino County Youth Only 5-19 years of age

Rabbit Meat Pen Rules:

1. Entry consists of three rabbits all the same breed, any variety.
2. Three rabbits will count as one Rabbit Entry for this division only.
3. Actual Date of Birth & each Rabbit Tattoo number must be shown on the entry . Bill of Sale must be submitted at check-in.
4. Only Rabbit Meat Pens judged to be market and consumer ready (equivalent to Group 1 grade) will be eligible to compete in any and all Championships.
5. All Champion and Reserve Champion Meat Pens (top 2 pens from each class with a maximum of 8) will be sold in the Junior Livestock Auction on Saturday, May 30, 2020. Meat Pen Rabbits may not be entered in any other class.
6. All exhibitors that are 5 to 8 yrs. of age shall show as an independent.
7. Limit of two entries per exhibitor for Rabbit Meat Pens.
