Chocolate Pie Contest Guidelines

- ◆ No pre-registration is necessary, but is preferred. Limit of one entry per participant.
- ◆ Pie will admit the **participant only** to the Fairgrounds **free** of charge on the day of the contest.
- ◆ Bring your pie to the **Foods Department** at 2 p.m. on **Sunday, May 24, 2020** through **Gate B**.
- ◆ The pie may or may not have a topping. Be creative but make sure your main ingredient is chocolate.
- ◆ No pie shall have ready-mixes of any kind including topping, crust, fillings, etc. No restrictions on size of pie.
- ◆ **A complete recipe**, which includes all parts of the entry, must accompany pies. Recipes need not be original. They must be legible.
- ◆ All recipes become the property of the San Bernardino County Fair.
- ◆ Judging will take place at 3 p.m. and is open to public viewing.
- ◆ The 1st place pie will be put on display for the duration of the Fair. All other entries will be returned to participants following judging.

Home Brew

Home Brew Contest Guidelines

- ◆ **Entries must be received Friday, May 22, 2020 from 9am-12pm in the Foods Department.**
- ◆ **Live Judging will be Monday, May 25, 2020 at 2pm**
- ◆ **Must be Homemade.**
- ◆ No individual brewer or single team of brewers may submit more than one (1) entry per class. This includes the Specialty class.
- ◆ An entry consists of 3—12oz. Or 2—22oz. bottles. Bottles can be any color but must be free of all ink, paint, or paper-labeling other than competition entry labels. One for individual class judging. For those who place first in their individual class one will be used in the judging for best of show.
- ◆ One entry form must be completed for each entrant or team of entrants.
- ◆ Each bottle must be labeled clearly with exhibitor information. And attached to each bottle by **Rubber Band**. Also, be as specific as you are able in details for your entry. Types of yeast, malts hops, barrel aging used, processes etc.. The more the information the better.
- ◆ All entries must be brewed in California.
- ◆ Each entry must have been brewed by the brewer(s) identified on the entrant information form.
- ◆ Entries may not be blends of two or more separately-brewed batches, except in the Specialty class.
- ◆ All entries become the property of the San Bernardino County Fair at the time they are accepted at the drop-off. Unused portions will not be returned to entrants and may be disposed of as necessary.
