**II. Job Functions**

Under the direction of the Arena Coordinator and/or Coordinator's Designee Barrel Setter and Event Aide is responsible for setting barrels during the Salinas Valley Fair sponsored barrel races and maintaining the cleanliness of the arena area.

**Function #1 Barrel Setter**

- Placement of barrels between drags and/or when knocked down by racer

**Function #2 Monitor Gates**

- Open and close gates to racers as directed by the Arena Coordinator

**Function #4 Light Janitorial**

- General cleanup of arena area before and after race as directed by Arena Coordinator
- Moving Tables and Chairs

**Function #5 Miscellaneous Duties**

- Perform miscellaneous duties as assigned by Arena Coordinator or CEO within the scope of the performance of the Salinas Valley Fair sponsored barrel race.

**III. Work Environment**

- Work is done outside and also inside fairgrounds buildings.
- Work is performed on weeknights and weekends.
- Must be able to sit and stand for long periods of time.
- Equipment/tools available to accomplish tasks will be provided.
