

King City Flea Market
at the Salinas Valley Fairgrounds
Rules & Regulations

The following rules and regulations must be adhered to at the weekly King City Flea Market at the Salinas Valley Fairgrounds. These rules are for the welfare and safety of the vendors and the public.

1. The Flea Market Manager is Teresa Navarro, herein referred to as the Manager. The Manager has the last word on any and all rules of the Flea Market. She has the right to ask you to leave if you are not obeying the rules. If needed she will call the King City Police Department to escort you off the fairgrounds and you will not be allowed back.
2. Vendors can come on to the grounds to start setting up their space at 5:00am, at 6:30am no more entry. The Manager will show you your assigned space. Gates open to the public at 7:00am. During regular Market hours any additional merchandise brought in/out of the Market by a vendor must be hand carried or transported on small hand cart in a safe manner as directed by the Manager.
3. All Dealers are required to keep their merchandise within their allotted space at all times including merchandise awaiting customer pick-up.
4. All radios and TV's must be kept at a low volume so as not to disturb other vendors or shoppers. The Market reserves the right to monitor music being played. If deemed unacceptable, you will be asked to turn the device completely off.
5. Merchandise must be displayed in a safe and neat manner at all times. Displays are to be designed so as not to block the view of nearby spaces or customers walking in the Flea Market as determined by the Manager.
6. Any electrical extension cord that is being used by a vendor must be of an approved type as determined by the fire marshal and must not present a trip-and-fall hazard.
7. All food vendors must have their health permit from the Monterey County Health Department, City Business License and Sellers Permit number if selling readily consumable products (i.e. ice cream – yes, packaged foods – yes, produce - no). Any vendor who fails to submit the required licenses/permits or who is not in compliance with all rules and regulations of said licenses/permits will be denied selling privileges at the Market.
8. All produce vendors must have the price of each item they are selling posted next to the product. This is for the convenience of the customers.
9. Absolutely no food items (soda, water, fresh or packaged food) may be sold at the flea market unless you have been authorized to do so by the Manager. Not obeying this rule is grounds for removal.
10. All vendors selling "garage sale" items can only sell twice in a year. If you sell more than twice a year you are required to have a King City Business License and a Sellers Permit number. These must be presented to the Manager for her to keep on file. Failure to turn in your licenses to the Manager on a timely manner may result in you no longer selling at the Flea Market.
11. All unsold items must be taken off the fairgrounds. Please do not place them in the trash cans.
12. Banned items including, but not limited to: alcohol, ammunition, guns, knives, explosive materials, dangerous, hazardous, flammable, toxic substances, illegal drugs, drug paraphernalia, offensive, pornographic or x-rated material, stolen, counterfeit or unlicensed items, any item that may present a public hazard, or any other illegal item(s). The Manager has the final authority in determining what can and cannot be sold on flea market property. If caught selling any of these items, you will be asked to leave the fairgrounds and the police may be called.
13. Space fees are at a set rate. There will be no refunds or credits.
14. The management reserves the right to refuse the sale of any product by the vendor.
15. Children must be under vendors control and at vendors rented space unless accompanied by an adult.
16. Any violations of the law or the above rules and regulations are punishable by suspension from the Flea Market. Refunds are not given to suspended vendors.
