

# Monterey International Wine Competition Announces Awards

KING CITY, CA — The 2018 Monterey International Wine Competition, wrapped up on Saturday, March 3rd at the Salinas Valley

Faigrounds in King City. Eighteen judges representing all aspects of the wine industry swirled and sipped through 773 entries, resulting in the selection of 50 Platinum Award winners, 150 Gold Award winners and 32 “Best Of” designations.

Platinum awards are reserved for wines scoring 94 points and higher, with gold honors awarded to wines scoring 90 to 93 points. Wines scoring a minimum of 90 points and the highest point

total in each category are recognized as “Best Of” for the 2018 competition.

Special honors include Wine of the Year — 2015 V. Sattui Cabernet Sauvignon Morisoli Vineyards (97 points) and the Best of Monterey County — 2016 Hahn Family Wines, Syrah Santa Lucia Highlands Estate Vineyard (96 points).

This year’s Winery of the Year is awarded to Carol Shelton Wines of Santa Rosa, CA. This

award recognizes the overall quality of the wines entered in the competition. “As always over my ten year association with the competition, entrants showed that their wines have a place on the world stage among the finest of their types and regions, and MIWC is proud to celebrate their achievements.” Said *Rich Cook, Director and Chief Judge of the competition.*

In 2018, judges were also asked to find the best wine and chocolate pairings. Marich chocolate company of Hollister, CA provided a variety of confections to compliment the breadth of wines entered in the competition. In a blind tasting, judges selected the V. Sattui 15 Year Aged Port (94 points) to pair with the Marich Chocolate Bourbon Caramels. To pair with Marich dark chocolate strawberry balsamic, a Sutter Home White Merlot was chosen.
