FEES & SHOW INFORMATION

ENTRY FEES

Performance & Halter Entries are \$14.00 per class per judge. There is a \$60 maximum charge PER division per judge. Therefore, anytime more than 4 classes are entered in one division, the charge shall not exceed \$60.00

Novice classes only count toward the Novice Division. For example, Novice Amateur classes do NOT count toward the maximum in the Amateur division or vice versa.

In halter classes only, if you enter a class as an Amateur, Am Select, or Youth you may enter the exact same Open halter class for free. Must be the same exhibitor/horse combination.

OFFICE FEE:

An office fee of \$10.00 per horse will be charged. This is a one-time fee per show weekend. This fee will be waived for an exhibitor that competes in only Youth and/or Novice Youth classes.

DRUG TESTING FEE:

The AQHA requires that all horses entered in the show pay a \$6.00 drug testing fee PER JUDGE.

GROUNDS FEE:

Any horse attending the show but not stalling on the grounds will be accessed a one-time \$15.00.

TRAIL COURSES:

All trail courses are designed by AS Trail Equipment & Services.

AWARDS:

All 1st Places will win a t-shirt available at the top of the bleachers in the arena.

For the four show series (total of 4 shows) held over the weekend:

Open Grand & Reserve Grand Champion Stallion Amateur Grand & Reserve Grand Champion Stallion Open Grand & Reserve Grand Champion Mare Amateur Grand & Reserve Grand Champion Mare Youth Grand & Reserve Grand Champion Mare Open Grand & Reserve Grand Champion Gelding Amateur Grand & Reserve Grand Champion Gelding Youth Grand & Reserve Grand Champion Gelding Halter Circuit Awards are determined by 2 points for a grand placing and 1 point for a reserve. In case of a tie for All-Around or circuit award - Judge A on Saturday will be the tie breaker.

All Around and Runner-Up in each division:

Open, Amateur, Amateur "Select," Youth 13 & Under, Youth 14-18, Novice Amateur, Novice Youth All-Around and runner-up will be awarded to contestants earning the most points over the four shows.

Rules for All-Around FOR SAN ANGELO SHOWS:

To qualify for any all-around, a horse/rider combination must enter at least 3 classes per show. Halter is <u>not</u> mandatory, but points earned at halter do go toward the all-around. <u>Halter points will only be eligible for Amateur</u> and Youth classes. Novice divisions do NOT get points for <u>halter or any other class that novice is not offered</u>. For example, a person showing in an Amateur halter class will not receive points in the Novice division for halter class. If a horse is judged for grand and reserve champion, these points will not be included in the all-around total. In the all ages youth classes, the youth will receive the points earned in an all age class. The age groups will not be placed separately. **Point system: Will follow AQHA Rules.** (Disqualified contestants will not receive points toward all-around).

TRAIL PRACTICE

Trail will be set-up at will on Thursday evening beginning around 5:00 p.m. and will remain open all evening for Friday's classes. After trail classes conclude on Friday, the pattern for Saturday will be set in the Cattle Barn. Once set up is complete, the barn will be open for practice and will be shut down 1 hour before show time Saturday morning.
