RULES & REGULATIONS

*All vehicles entering the RV area must be able to provide proof of valid, current vehicle insurance.

*Only one personal vehicle per RV/trailer space will be allowed and ONLY if it fits within designated area. Any unattended personal vehicles parked in the RV area will be towed at the owner's expense. For vehicles too large to fit within the RV space, said vehicles shall be parked in a parking space. All vehicles must display the proper permit at all times. Driving or parking off road is not permitted. Speed limit is 5 MPH. Drivers must obey all traffic signs and operate their vehicles in accordance with posted regulations and applicable Federal, State, and local laws.

***NO PETS ALLOWED.** DO NOT BRING YOUR PET TO THE LIVESTOCK BARN AREA OR TO THE FAIR.

*All personal equipment must be kept neat and tidy within your assigned site. RV sites must be kept clean for the enjoyment of all our guests. Do not carve, chop, cut, or damage any trees in the RV area.

*At no time may an extension cord be stretched across a road or a fire lane to supply electricity to other RVs or stock trailers/trucks. No multiple tie-ins will be allowed. Electrical cords must be in good condition and extension cords must not interfere with foot traffic.

***NO TENTS ALLOWED.**

***NO FIRES ALLOWED.** Fully contained BBQ grills and camping stoves are OK.

***NO LOUD RADIOS OR MUSIC AT ANYTIME.** Quiet hours are between Midnight and 7:00 am. No loud talking or generators. Please be considerate of others. Disorderly conduct will not be tolerated. **Junior exhibitors, see Code of Conduct in the Local Rules, Exhibitor Handbook. See also Local Rule #25.**

***ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES:** No alcoholic beverages are allowed outside of RV/Trailer space. (See below for Alcohol Policy) Drugs, weapons, fighting, lewd conduct, reckless driving, speeding, motorized/non-motorized skateboards not permitted. **Junior Exhibitors, see Code of Conduct in the Local Rules, Exhibitor Handbook.**

*I agree to assume all responsibility for the conduct of the above Junior Exhibitors & minor children under my care while they are attending the Silver Dollar Fair.

*I understand that the 3rd District Agricultural Association assumes no responsibility for any one person given permission to stay on the Fairgrounds of the 3rd DAA and will not be responsible for accidents or injury to our guests or for loss of money or valuables of any kind.

*I understand permission may be revoked at any time at the discretion of the Management. I agree to abide by all rules prescribed by the Fair Association.

MINORS IN POSSESSION AND RV AREA ALCOHOL POLICY

* It is the policy of the 3rd District Agricultural Association that any minors possessing or under the influence of alcoholic beverages or drugs on the Fairgrounds will be required to leave the Fairgrounds under the supervision of a responsible adult. If the minor is an Exhibitor at the Fair, he/she will not be able to exhibit, show, or sell their project.

* Alcoholic beverages in any of the RV/Trailer camping areas will be allowed under the following conditions:

- a. A responsible adult tenant must be in control of all alcoholic beverages at all times.
- b. Alcoholic beverages outside the RV must be in a non-identifiable container.
- c. Alcoholic beverages are not allowed outside of the RV/Trailer area.

* Violation of the alcohol policy of the 3rd DAA could result in expulsion from the Fairgrounds, loss of Exhibitor privileges and future camping privileges.
