Combined breeds will only have one Champion and Reserve Champion.

Premiums: Classes will not be paid out for the 2020 fair with entry fees being waived.

Breed Grand Champions and Supreme Champions will be paid as usual with premiums as listed below.

Specific Information:

- **Show will follow Sioux Empire Fair General Livestock Show Rules and Health Regulations.**
- **Milking parlor available on-site. Milk is not sold.**
- **All Livestock Exhibitors will need to pay fair admission during admission hours. No stamps are given to exhibitors without paying admission.**
- **Certificates of Registry:** All animals entered under a breed classification must have been recorded in an association recognized by the particular breed. Entry numbers must be furnished on the entry blanks when necessary. Exhibitors must produce a certificate of registry at the time of check in to the superintendent in charge of the department. General Authority: SDCL 1-12-10. Law implemented: SDCL 1-21-10. Only registered Brown Swiss females with a six digit registration number are eligible for show competition.

A=Junior Show C=Open Show**

Group Classes:

4034. Junior Best 3 females – This group to consist of 3 females from the heifer division, none of which have freshened, all bred and at least one owned by the exhibitor

4035. Senior Best 3 Females – This group must consist of 3 cows over 2 years of age all bred and at least one owned by the exhibitor.

4036. Produce of Dam – Two animals, any age, either sex, the produce of one cow.

4037. Daughter-Dam – Both animals owned by the exhibitor.
