All entries must have been home produced by the exhibitor within one year of the opening date of the fair. Items that have been previously shown at the Siskiyou Golden Fair are not eligible. Classes may be combined depending on number of entries received.

There will be no premiums awarded and ribbons will be available for pickup at the fair office if desired.

Items **MUST** be entered into the Blue Ribbon program on the website, www.sisqfair.com by the deadline of July 24th; each exhibitor needs to create a new account for this year. Photos of entries **MUST** be emailed & received by July 31st at 5:00 PM to candc@sisqfair.com. You can submit 4-6 photos of the entry but no larger than 1 mb (for Clothing, Textiles, Arts & Crafts). For Photography, 1-2 photos of the entry may be submitted but no larger than 1 mb. There is to be only one entry per email.

The name and class entered must be in the subject line of the email.

Paper entry forms or actual items **WILL NOT** be received in the office.

Results will be announced on Wednesday, August 12, 2020.

Open – 19 years old & older as of January 1st

Definitions (open classes):

- Beginner: Open to exhibitors, who are just starting out in any art medium (pencil, ink, watercolor, etc.), and have engaged in artwork as a pastime or hobby. Exhibitors cannot remain in this class after winning a blue ribbon at the Siskiyou Golden Fair.
- Intermediate: Open to advancing artists who have been drawing or painting for two or more years and whose sales, if any, do not exceed the cost of the materials for the article sold and who are not otherwise remunerated on account of engaging in this work except for cash prizes or premiums.
- Advanced: Open to artists whose ability and skills are beyond the intermediate level, or those who choose to market their artwork on a regular basis in a businesslike manner, and whose sales have exceeded the cost of materials used.

Open – 19 years old & older as of January 1st

Definitions (open classes):

- Beginner: Open to exhibitors who are just starting out in the photography medium and take pictures as a pastime or hobby. Exhibitors cannot remain in this class after winning a blue ribbon at the Siskiyou Golden Fair.
- Intermediate: Open to advancing photographers who have been taking pictures for some time. The intermediate classes offer exhibitors opportunities to compete on a higher level.
- Advanced: Open to photographers whose sales, if any, do not exceed the cost of the materials for the article sold and who are not otherwise remunerated on account of engaging in this work except for cash prizes or premium awards.
- Professional: Open to photographers who teach, sell regularly, have gallery shows or possess skills at the highest level of the medium.
