Siskiyou Golden Fair Junior Fair Board mission statement:

“To support the mission of the Siskiyou Golden Fair while developing leadership skills and responsibility attributes; while setting an example for our peers and serving as fair ambassadors.”

As part of our mission up to three (3) scholarships will be awarded to graduating seniors in Siskiyou County; one will be to a current Junior Fair Board Member.

Scholarships will be in the amounts of (1) \$500 and one (1) \$250 (open to non-board members), and one (1) \$500 scholarship to a current Junior Fair Board member. Pending on applications received, the Junior Fair Board reserves the right to combine amounts or not award a scholarship.

Deadline:

- Applications must be delivered to the Fair Office no later than **5:00 PM on WEDNESDAY, JULY 1, 2020.**

Requirements:

- Must be a graduating senior in Siskiyou County.
- Must have a minimum of a 2.0 cumulative GPA.
- Must have at least two years involvement in the Siskiyou Golden Fair: livestock or still exhibits.
- Include one (1) letter of recommendation.
- Include an unofficial school transcript for proof of your current GPA.
- All personal information must be completed, and application needs to be typed on a separate sheet of paper.
- For the Junior Fair Board Member scholarship: applicant must be a current member of the 2019-2020 board.

Awards:

- Scholarships will be awarded at the Opening Ceremony Presentation at the Siskiyou Golden Fair on **WEDNESDAY, AUGUST 12th at 5:00 PM.** (located at the flagpole at the north end of the fairgrounds).
- Recipients must present proof of college enrollment to the Fair Office by December 31, 2020 or funds will be forfeit.
