
Exit at Southern Boulevard. Exit # 68. Go west approximately 7 miles to Sansbury's Way. Fairgrounds will be on your right.

#### GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR ALL INSIDE COMPETITIVE EXHIBITS

- 1. All classes in each section are open to Florida residents.
- 2. Amateurs and professionals will be judged separately.
- 3. Entries made from kits will be judged separately.
- Adults, Juniors and Seniors will be judged separately. Individual school groups will be judged separately.

Junior age - 16 or under Adult age - 17 to 59 Senior age - 60 or over

- 5. All entries must be handmade by the entrant within the past two years.
- 6. The Fair will make every effort to exhibit each article entered, but reserves the right to decide which articles will be displayed in the event space. Arrangements can be made prior to the Fair's opening to pickup any entry not being displayed.
- 7. All articles entered for competition must remain in place until the last day of the Fair and can only be picked up on Monday, February 3.
- 8. The judging committee reserves the right to not accept any article that does not meet the criteria.
- 9. Any article not claimed within 30 days after the Fair's closing will become property of the Fair, unless arrangements are made in writing.
- 10. While every care will be exercised in the handling of all articles, the Fair cannot assume responsibility for damage or loss.
- 11. At the judges' discretion, all classes may be subdivided. The decision of the judges is final.
- 12. In keeping with the South Florida Fair's family orientation, items of an offensive, controversial or objectionable nature or subject matter will not be accepted.
- 13. See specific division rules that apply to certain categories.



#### Special Rules


1. All entered items must be securely mounted on standard single weight black or white mat board (no double matting) to the specified outer dimensions of 11 inches x 14 inches with a thickness not to exceed 1/16th inches. No hangers, no foam core mounts, no masonite mounts, no cardboard or scotch taped items will be allowed to compete. This rule is to protect your artwork. Any entered item not complying with these specifications will be disqualified by the judges and not displayed. Ask your processing lab to dry mount your entered item(s) to the specifications outlined.

- 2. Print size can be no smaller that 8 inches x 10 inches, and no larger than 11 inches x 14 inches. Any print that does not fit within this size limitation will be disqualified. Finished size must be 11 inches x 14 inches.
- 3. Exhibitor's name and address must be clearly printed on each print and case.

#### SOUTH FLORIDA FAIR CULINARY COMPETITION

#### Rules & Regulations

- 1. All foods will be judged on appearance, texture, taste, and procedure.
- 2. Recipe MUST accompany entry and MUST include entrant's name.
- 3. Canning dates must be on jars.
- 4. All jars must be regulation canning jars only, using 2 piece lids. No paraffin or sealing will be permitted. Broken seals will be disqualified.
- 5. Juniors will be judged separately in all categories.
- 6. Restrictive diet foods will be judged separately in all categories.
- 7. Judging will be the same day as entries are submitted, and awards will be presented immediately following judging. Award time and place will be announced at registration.
- 8. Judging area will be closed to the public.
- 9. Entries will not be returned at close of judging.
- 10. Recipes become the property of the South Florida Fair.

This is the 35th year for the contest, where the Palm Beach County Quilters' Guild members design a quilt top with the winning blocks, which is then quilted and displayed at the PBCQG booth located in Building 5 during the South Florida Fair, January 17 - February 2, 2020. Previous contest quilts are displayed during the Fair and are available upon request for display at quilt shows and museums throughout the country.

#### **RULES & ELIGIBILITY**

- 1. The contest is open to anyone. Employees of the South Florida Fair and their immediate families are not eligible for cash prizes.
- 2. Blocks made by more than one person will not be accepted for judging. The quilt block must conform to the contest theme, 'PLAY BALL, PLAY FAIR!'. You may design your own block or make a traditional block recognizable to the theme, including anything that is recognized as pertaining to 'PLAY BALL, PLAY FAIR!'.
- 3. The completed block must measure 13 inches square or larger. It will be sewn to a finished size 12 inches square in the quilt. Be sure to confine your design within the finished 12-inch square. The extra inch allows for design choices, and for seaming and alignment of blocks.
- 4. Any technique (patchwork, appliqué—hand or machine, etc.) is acceptable as long as it is attached so it will not come off and will lay flat for the finish quilting and can be quilted.
- 5. Embellishments or threadwork must be securely attached and not distort the block, so the block will lay flat.
- 6. Fabrics must be woven, pre-washed, 100 percent cotton.
- 7. Do NOT quilt your block.
- 8. Do NOT finish the edge of your block by hemming, zigzagging or bordering.
- 9. You can enter more than one block, but only one block per person can win and be included in the quilt.

#### **HOW TO ENTER**

- 1. Complete the official entry form (also available online at: www.palmbeachquilters.org, your local Quilt shops or by sending a self-addressed, stamped legal-sized envelope to: Palm Beach County Quilters' Guild, Attn: Fair Block Contest: P.O. Box 18276, West Palm Beach FL 33416.)
- 2. Safety pin the completed entry form to the back of the block. DO NOT sign your name on the front of the block.

Deadline for blocks must be postmarked by September 28, 2019. No Exceptions.

#### **CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

- All winning quilt blocks become the property of the SOUTH FLORIDA FAIR and PALM BEACH COUNTY QUILTERS' GUILD.
- 2. The SOUTH FLORIDA FAIR and PALM BEACH COUNTY QUILTERS' GUILD is not be responsible for lost, late or misdirected mail.
- 3. Illegible, incomplete or damaged entry blanks or quilt blocks will be disqualified.
- 4. Quilt blocks that are too small will not be accepted.

#### JUDGING

All quilt blocks will be judged by qualified quilt judges, selected by PALM BEACH COUNTY QUILTERS' GUILD.

#### **NOTIFICATION OF WINNERS**

Winners will be selected and notified by mail along with a judge's critique. Non-winning blocks will be returned, if requested.

The 2020 South Florida Fair quilt block theme is Play Ball, Play Fair! Celebrating all things sports-related, there are endless possibilities involving ball sports and quilting shapes. So take me out to the ball game! Baseball: America's own pastime is rich with possibilities. The diamond-shaped field, the stitching on the ball (108, fyi) is meant for quilters! Bats and gloves, the stadiums and crowds, peanuts, hot dogs and beer. This is summer defined by a sport.

Football: Oh, the teams and rivalries. The ball (eight stitches on the pigskin), the 50-yard line on the striped field, the striped referees, the striped helmets.

Pennants and mascots: Colorful designs abound here for those who like embellishing.

Tennis — heroes and heroines on the courts. What a racquet! Tons of rectangles to work on.

Golf: One-on-one competition mostly with yourself. The pin, the tin cup, the clubs, flags and the dimpled ball. Circle quilters have a field day, of course!

Volleyball: All we can think is playing volleyball in Top Gun. You go from there.

Soccer (European football): Look at all the pentagons and hexagons on the ball! Flatten one out and you have Grandmother's flower garden!

Don't forget the lesser known ball sports: racquetball, paddleball, croquet and cricket, polo – land and water, lacrosse, kickball, and now for you oldsters, pickleball.

Get rolling, quilters! Play ball!
