

2019 St. Charles County Fair Queen Pageant Official Rules and Regulations

The St. Charles County Fair Queen Contest competition and pageant is held annually in conjunction with the St. Charles County Fair. The Fair will be held on July 23rd - July 27th, 2019 at Rotary Park in Wentzville. Entrants agree to abide by all the rules of the St. Charles County Fair Queen Pageant, which are in effect now or as announced later. Entrants agree that the time, manner and method of judging shall solely be at the discretion of the St. Charles County Fair Queen Committee and that the decision of the judges will be final.

Official Rules and Regulations

- The contest is limited to the first 15 contestants by postmark or date turned in. **No late entries will be accepted.**
- Contestants shall be female and have a desire to represent of the St. Charles County Fair and all that the fair stands for.
- Contestants must be at least 17 years old, but no older than 21 years by July 1, 2019.
- Contestants shall be single and not cohabiting with a male, or at any time have been married, pregnant, or have had a child. A contestant must have never been convicted of any crime or have any criminal charges pending.
- Contestants can only compete 2 consecutive years.
- Entry fees, 2 wallet size headshots and the official entry form must be sent to Hilary Eisenbath (3456 Brookside Crossing Dr. St. Charles, MO 63301) by Monday, June 10, 2019.

A complete entry will include the following:

- \$50.00 entry fee by way of sponsor with checks made payable to: St. Charles County Fair
- Completed official entry form.
- 2 wallet size pictures of good quality (head and shoulders only). *NOTE: photo can also be emailed to Hilarywehmeyer@gmail.com. Please make note of that in entry form.*
- Signed liability waiver.

Selection of the St. Charles Co. Fair Queen will be based on the following:

Participation of events- 15 points

Personal Interview (personality, communication) -30 points/judge

Portfolio (presentation, grammar) -30 points/judge

Speech / Talent (entertainment value, originality, delivery) -25 points/judge

On-stage question (poise, communication)- 10 points/judge

- Winners will receive prizes, cash and the opportunity to represent the St. Charles County Fair as the Queen and/or her court.
- The Queen must be present through the duration of the fair. The Runners-Up, Miss Congeniality, and Miss Talent will be required to attend activities during the fair as well. A schedule will be worked out with these winners. Prizes will be withheld if duties are not completed. Prizes will be given to the top winners on the closing evening of the Fair.
- The St. Charles County Fair Queen will automatically relinquish her title if she enters into a marriage contract or if she chooses to cohabit with a male in lieu of a marriage contract.
- If the Queen fails to complete her term, the title will be passed to the runner's-up in order of their rank, beginning with 1st runner-up.
- The 2019 St. Charles County Fair Queen may represent St. Charles County at the 2019 Missouri State Fair Queen Pageant in Sedalia, MO. *If the 2018 Queen is unable to compete in the Missouri State Fair Queen Pageant, the runners up will be asked to participate in her place in order of rank.*
- Conduct deemed to be improper and detrimental to the St. Charles County Fair and/or the Queen Contest will be reason for disqualification and dismissal by the Fair Queen Committee.
