SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

General Information

1. Scholarship applications will be judged by an independent panel of educators appointed by the St. Paul Rodeo Association Board of Directors.
2. Your completed application will be judged for accuracy, neatness and organization.
3. Two scholarships are awarded: (1) to a graduating St. Paul High School senior (2) to the child of a St. Paul Rodeo member. If eligible, one applicant may be considered for both categories but is not allowed to win both awards.
4. The amount of each scholarship is \$4,000.00.

Eligibility

1. Applicant must either be: a graduating senior from St. Paul High School or a child of a St. Paul Rodeo member.
2. The applicant may be a graduating high school senior, or a full time freshman, sophomore or junior at an accredited college.
3. The scholarship must be used within 2 years.
4. The winner of either scholarship is not eligible to reapply.

Criteria for Selection

Applications will be judged on the basis of scholastic achievement, school activities, honors, awards, community and volunteer activities.

Instructions

1. Complete page 2 of this application, attaching your personal statements and activities page(s) as instructed.
2. Provide a seven semester high school transcript, plus college transcript if applicable.
