OVERVIEW

Spectra is the proud provider of food and beverage for State Fair Park. Volunteers assist with concession stand operations as cashiers, vendors, and stand workers. ELIGIBILITY

- Groups are nonprofit, tax-exempt entities as defined in Section 501 of IRS code.
- NPO leader (authorized representative of NPO) signs a contract with your Federal Tax ID.
- Group has general liability insurance certificate and provides written proof that plan is at least \$1M and includes Spectra, State Fair Park, and Central Washington Fair Association, its officers, agents, and employees, the Board of Yakima County Commissioners in coverage.
- Volunteers are at least 16 years of age to participate; 21 years old to serve beer.
- Volunteers are positive/professional individuals with a passion for customer service.

COMMITMENT

- Groups provide a specific number of volunteers/group leaders for each event.
- Your group/pool of volunteers is fully defined before the season begins.
- Volunteers must each sign a waiver; minors must have a parent/guardian sign.
- Spectra provides all equipment, training, supplies, and uniforms for all volunteers.
- Spectra will present new special events and concerts as additional opportunities.

BENEFITS

- A unique opportunity to meet fundraising goals in a fun environment.
- Fundraising coordinators can concentrate their efforts on one program instead of numerous door-to-door campaigns, bake sales, car washes, etc.
